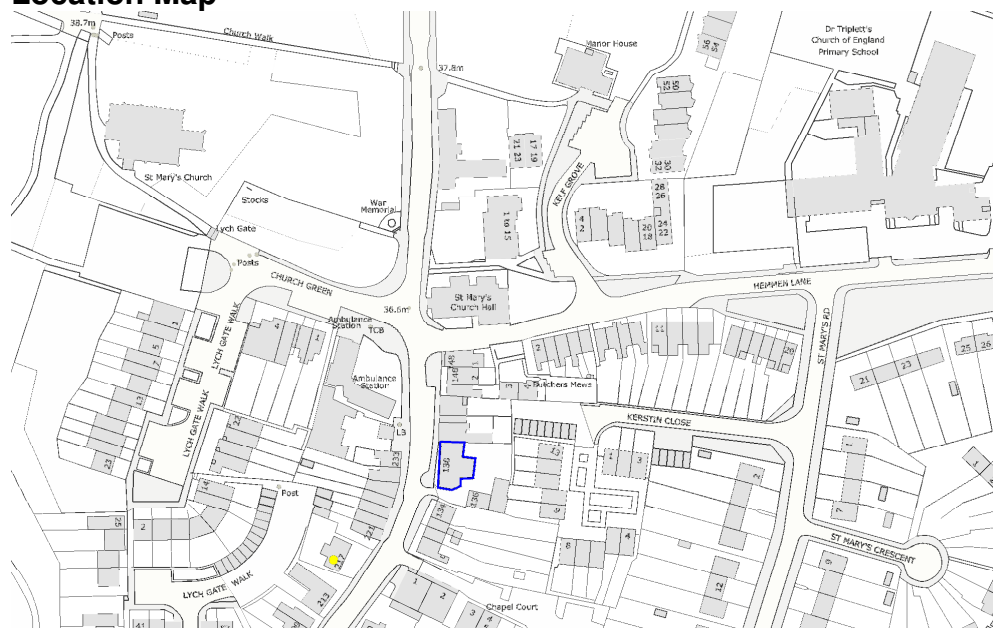
**Statement of significance/ Reasons for designation**

Architectural: Altered early 19<sup>th</sup> century front conceals 17<sup>th</sup> century core. Two storeys with attic. Slate mansard roof with three modern dormers. Rough rendered front with parapet. Central door with wide recess and rusticated pilasters.

Historic: Wistowe house was the home between 1908 and 1914 of BJ Edwards, a photographic pioneer who had small works for the production of photographic plates behind the house.
