Statement of significance/ Reasons for designation

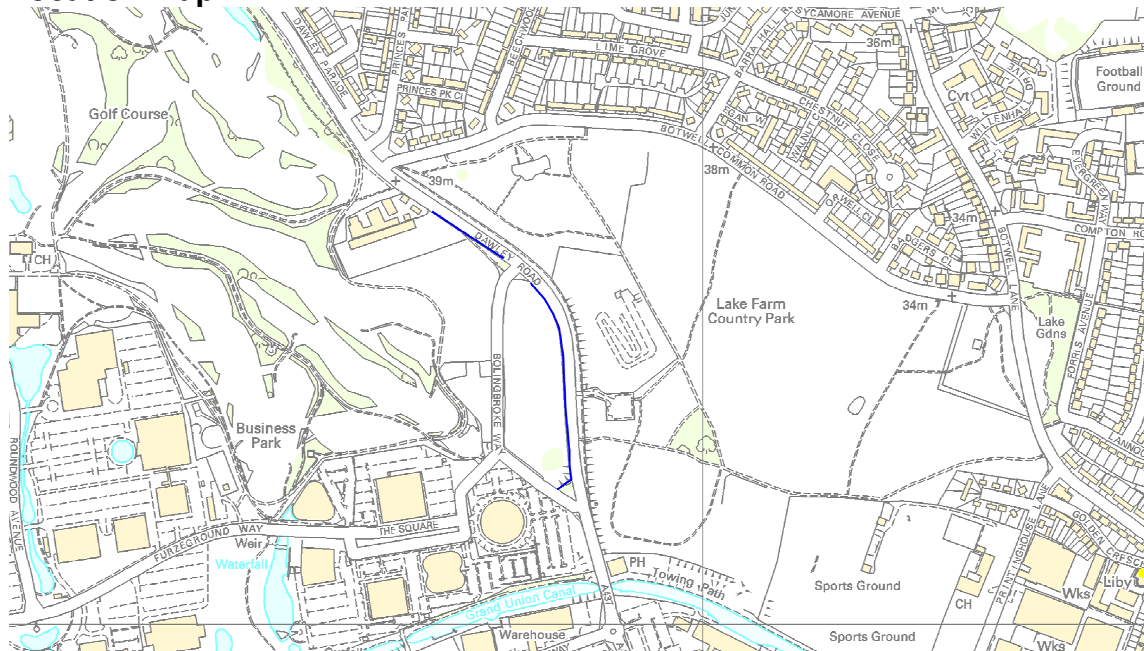
Architectural: 18th – early 19th century tall red brick wall. Upper part rebuilt in many places.

Townscape: Attractive feature contributing to street scene and local area.

Historic: Originally marking estate boundary and is all that remains of the extensive Dawley Estate. It dates from the mid-eighteenth century when the Earl of Uxbridge was Lord of the Manor of Dawley. The wall has been restored to form part of the boundary of Stockley Park.
