

Statement of significance/ Reasons for designation

<u>Architectural</u>: 18th – early 19thcentury tall red brick wall. Upper part rebuilt in many places.

<u>Townscape</u>: Attractive feature contributing to street scene and local area.

Historic: Originally marking estate boundary and is all that remains of the extensive Dawley Estate. It dates from the mideighteenth century when the Earl of Uxbridge was Lord of the Manor of Dawley. The wall has been restored to form part of the boundary of Stockley Park.
