Townscape: Key landmark.

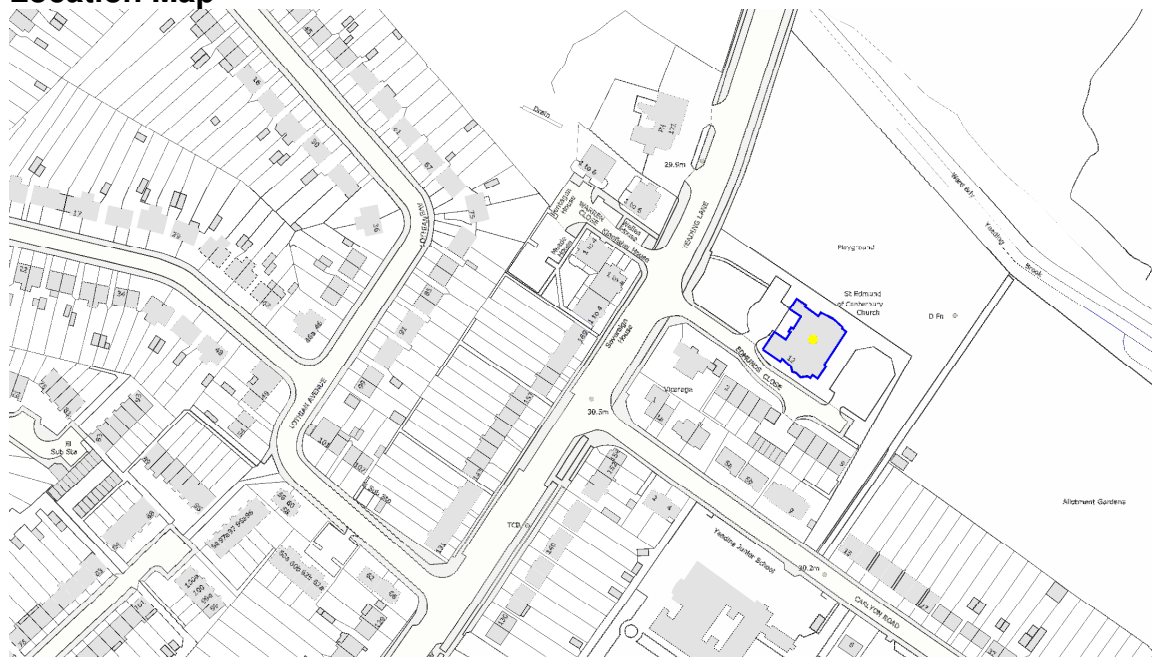
