**Statement of significance/ Reasons for designation**

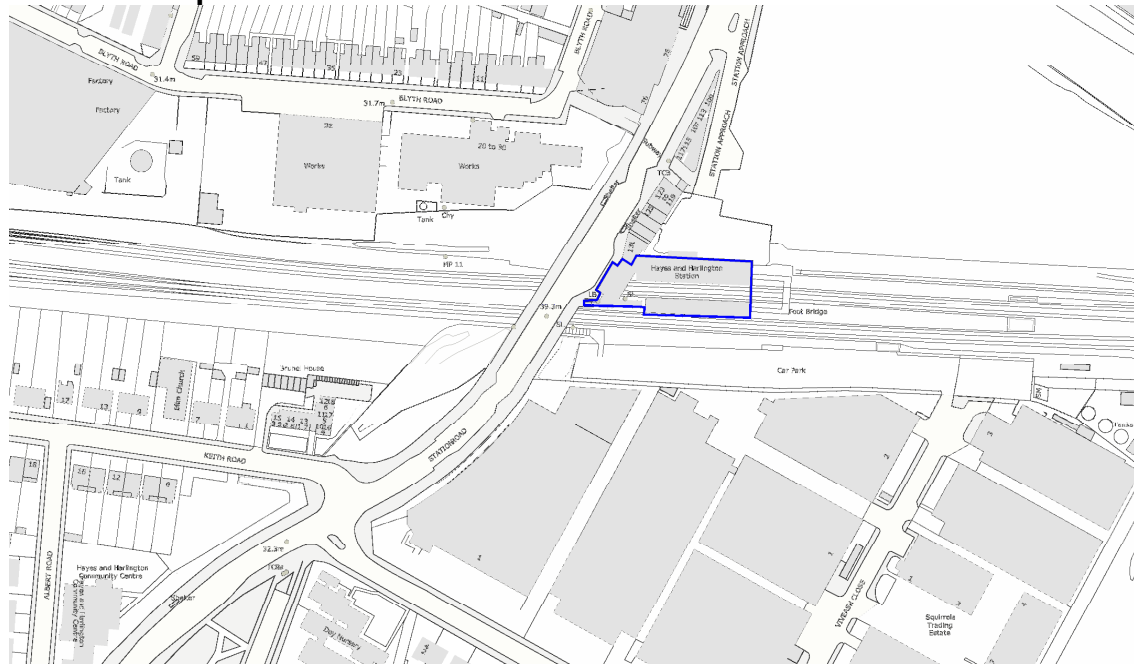
Architectural: Opened in 1868, and altered in circa 1920. Single storey horizontal building in red brick. Arched windows with painted hood arched lintels. All windows now replaced. Attractive brick chimneys. Corrugated metal roof.

Townscape: Key landmark and transport interchange point.

Historical: Associated with the development of Great Western Railways and Hayes.
