**Statement of significance/ Reasons for designation**

Architectural: 1926-28 by Hubert C Corlette. Aisled nave, chancel, bell turret. Mainly in yellow brick with red brick up to plinth level. On elevation fronting Station Road: large gable tapering to the top with brick quoins and hounds tooth eaves detail; one large gothic style window with tracery and two smaller windows on each side.

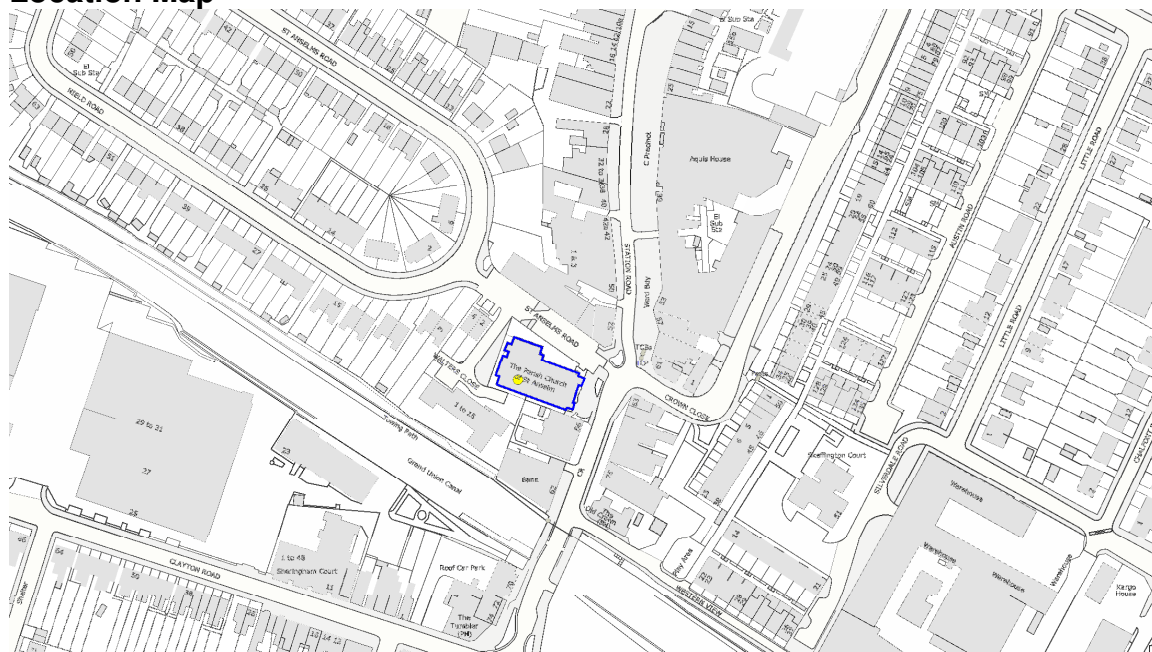
Townscape: Contributes to the local character.
