**Statement of significance/ Reasons for designation**

Architectural: Early 20<sup>th</sup> century. Two principal elevations, facing Uxbridge Road and Yeading Lane. Two and half storey, in brick with tiled roof. Upper floor rendered. Decorative timber detailing applied to elevation fronting Uxbridge Road. Open eaves. Exposed chimney breast and stack to the corner. Entrance through a modern gabled porch.

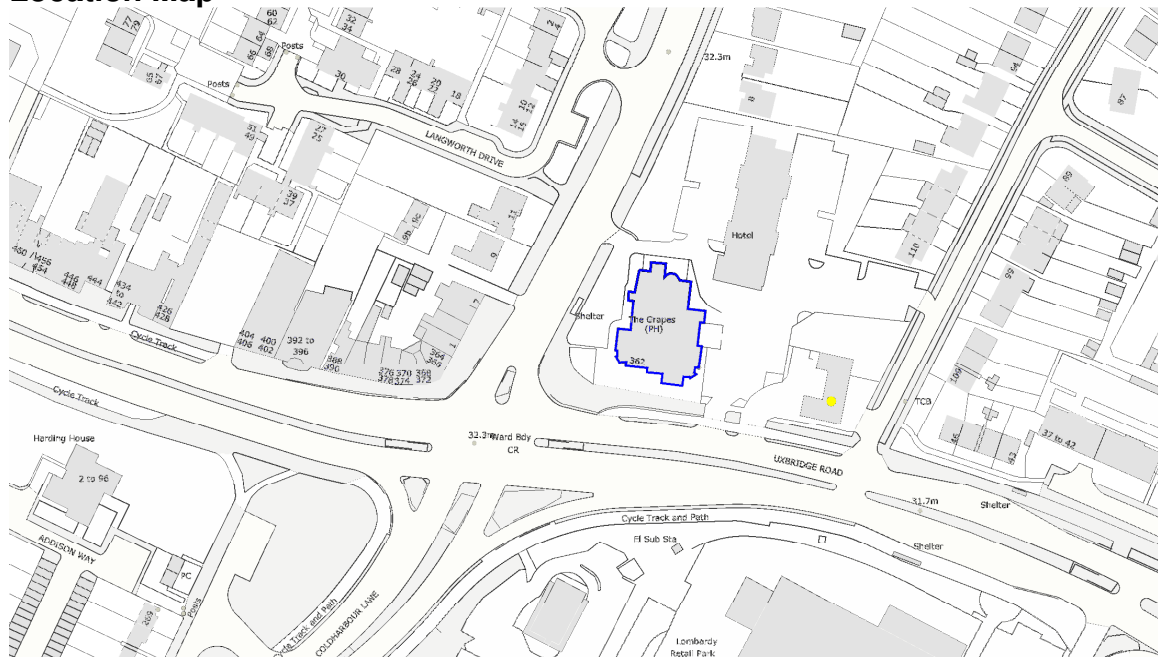
Townscape: Key landmark.
