Statement of significance/ Reasons for designation

Architectural: 1902, one of the only remaining 'Tin Terbangles' in the borough. Built as prefabricated kit using corrugated iron or zinc galvanised sheets.

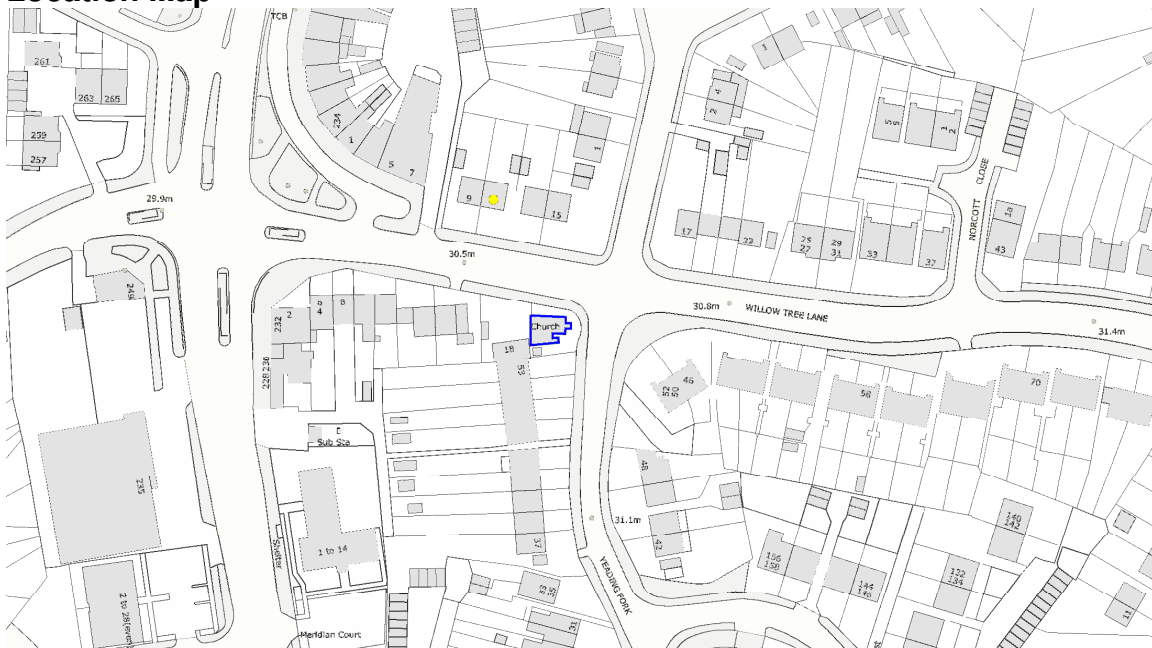
Historic: Opened as Mission Hall on 5th January 1902 in memory of Mr Charles Horace Harcourt. It was sponsored by Baptist and Methodist tradesmen from Ealing. By 1942 it had become Yeading Baptist Church and by the 1980s had become the Hayes Apostolic Protestant Church.
