Statement of significance/ Reasons for designation

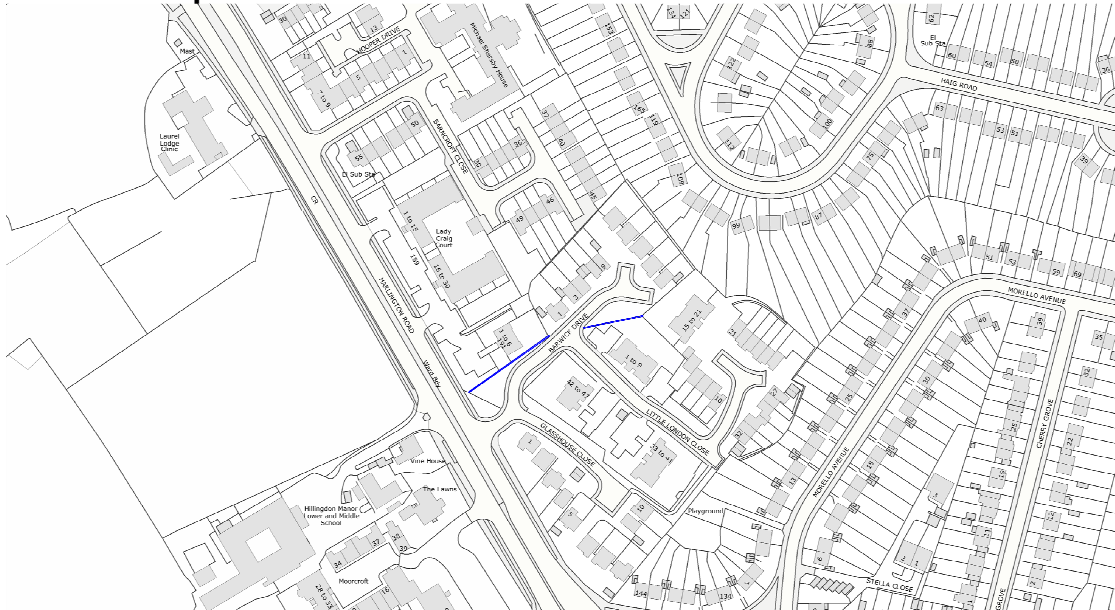
Architectural: 18th century walls of narrow, red stock brick, patched with yellow London stocks, laid in Flemish bond. Marks the northern, western and southern boundaries of the former house. Flat buttresses at intervals on western side. On northern side, V shaped. Brick coping and angled buttresses to rear.

Townscape: Contributes to street scene and local character

Historical: Only remaining structure surviving of former 18th century house
