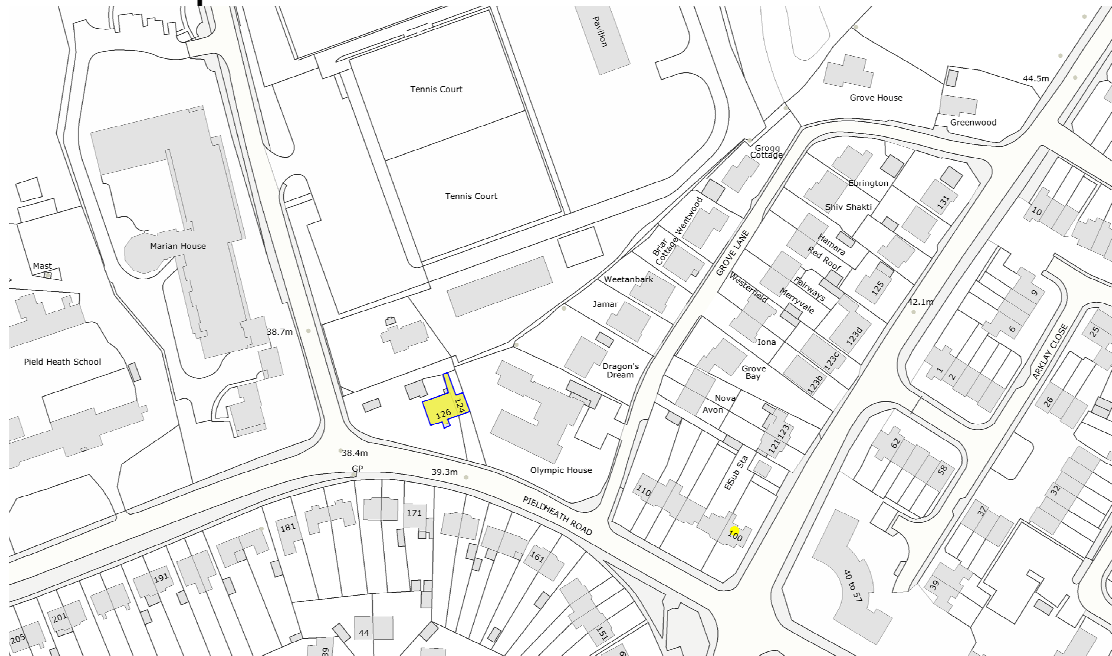
Statement of significance/ Reasons for designation

Architectural: No 126 is an early 18th century house with early 19th century and modern alterations. Front of two storeys, three windows wide. High pitched tiled roof with sprocketed eaves. Painted brick with diagonal brick eaves cornice. Projecting, gabled entrance in centre. First floor windows large modern casements. Ground floor windows early C19 long casements in moulded frames. Modern timber porch to early c19th door with rectangular fan light. Two hipped rear wings. No 128 is a two storey, one window stuccoed cottage with slate roof, of mid 19th century appearance and with newer windows; but it may have an older core.
