Statement of significance/ Reasons for designation

<u>Architectural</u>: Pair of semi-detached cottages date from the late-medieval period. Handed pair of timber framed one and half storey with rendered exterior and slate roof. Fabric much altered. Windows to the south west elevation are picturesque round headed timber casements of two to five lights. Probably mid C19, these have chamfered mullions under slender sloping canopies. Front entrance to No 15 has a round arched frame with continuous moulding. Adjoining wash house in white render and slate roof. No 13 extended northwards by a bay. Both with rear extensions.

Townscape: Picturesque setting. Group value

<u>Historic</u>: Associated with the Swakeleys Manor- built as the butler's and gamekeeper's cottages.
