


Statement of significance/ Reasons for designation

<u>Architectural</u>: Circular building of flint, with crenellations. Gothic arched openings of stone, on the inner side and arrow slit windows, with stone surround, to road.

<u>Townscape</u>: Contributes to local character and street scene. Key landmark.

<u>Historic</u>: Built c.1850 as Summer House/Folly for Northwood Hall, now named Denville Hall. Tower now in frontage of Nos.1-9 Kendall Manor.
