

Statement of significance/ Reasons for designation

<u>Architectural</u>: C1910. Line of houses by C.H.B. Quennell in "Arts and Crafts" style. Later additions and alterations. No 10, now in white render. No 12 in red brick with tiled hipped roof, slightly projecting right wing with gable. No 14, in dark red brick with lighter red brick for decorative use. Tile hung. Prominent central gable with exposed chimney breast. No 16, red brick with tiled hipped roof, dentil cornice. Large sash windows with gauged brick arches and key stone. Projecting right wing bay. Entrance through stone portico.

<u>Townscape</u>: Group value within Northwood- Frithwood Conservation Area. Contributes to an attractive street scene and the local character.
