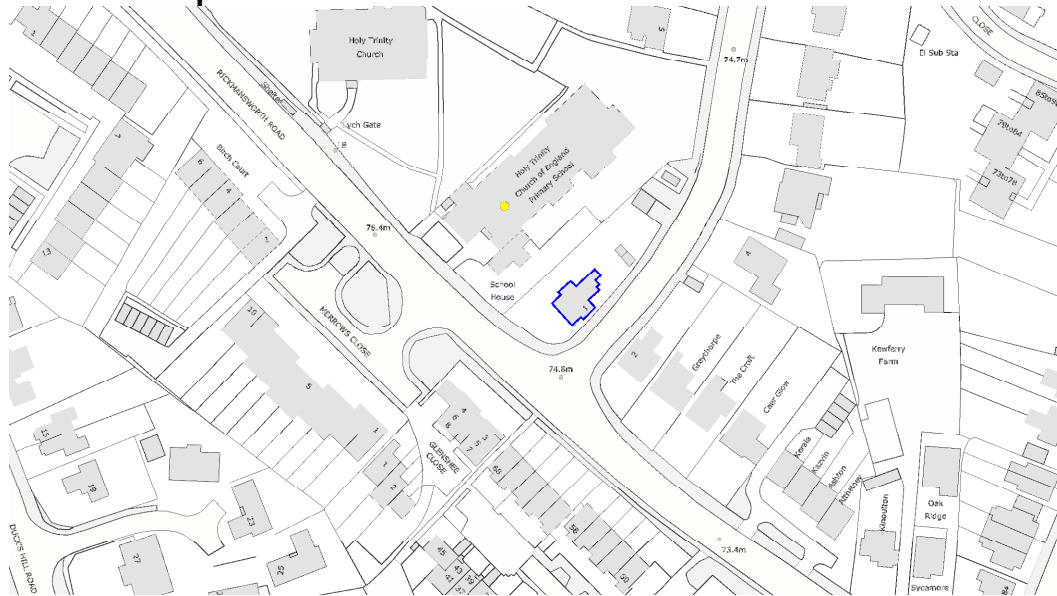


**Statement of significance/ Reasons for designation**

Architectural: Datestone: 1861. Formerly two cottages. Two storey in brick with tiled roof. Two prominent gables, with decorative wooden bargeboards, facing Rickmansworth Road, and one plainer gable facing Kewferry Road. Flat arched windows. Three chimneys.  
Townscape: Contributes to local character  
Historical: Built originally for workers of the local Grosvenor Estate. Associated with Lord Robert Grosvenor.
