Statement of significance/ Reasons for designation

Architectural: Purpose built by W Gilbee Scott in 1891-93 as a private girls' school, the building is in brick with many dormers and attractive chimney stacks breaking through the tiled roof. South elevation, smaller building with cranked gables and oriel windows. North west elevation, facing the playing field, pavilion type one and half storey building, in render with half timbering and cat slide tiled roof.

Townscape: Contributes to local character. Key landmark.

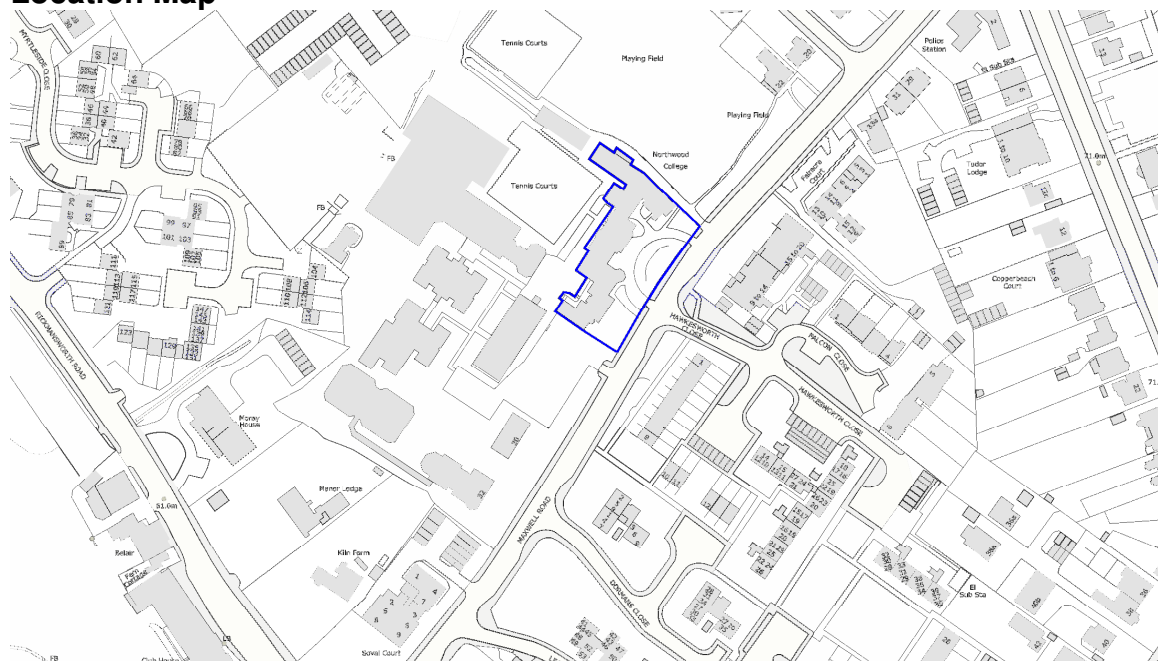
