
Statement of significance/ Reasons for designation

<u>Architectural</u>: Plain single storey, in white render. Slate pyramidal roof with a brick chimney at the apex. Built on the core of the original lodge.

<u>Townscape</u>: It is very important as part of the Manor Farm group, which contains buildings of all ages from the 13th to the 20th century.

<u>Historical</u>: The Lodge was built at the entrance to Manor Farm in the midnineteenth century. It housed farm bailiffs.
