
Statement of significance/ Reasons for designation

<u>Architectural</u>: War Memorial: three-tiered octagonal base surmounted by square plinth supporting stone crucifix. Inscription on metal plaques attached to the sides of the plinth. Top step incised depiction of chalice and host beneath feet of Christ figure. Frieze of roses carved around top of base. *Horse trough*: Large oblong sandstone with a sunken iron brace.

Townscape: War Memorial acts as a key landmark at this important junction.

<u>Historical</u>: The trough placed by Metropolitan Drinking Fountain and Cattle Trough Association, in front of The Old Bell Public House (1-3 High Street).
