
## Statement of significance/ Reasons for designation

Architectural: New Vicarage built in 1881. Two storey, red brick building with steep tiled roof and decorative ridge tiles. Three storey Gable facing front with gabled tile hung dormers. Diamond shaped chimney stacks. Arched doorway entrance, originally faced the River Pinn, but was moved to the Bury Street frontage in 1938. Brick arch detail over windows. Timber Sash windows with glazing bars, now replaced.
