


Statement of significance/ Reasons for designation

Architectural: 1920s three storey brick building on the corner with Ickenham Road. A prominent classically inspired composition. The bank is 5 windows wide, the 3 central bays are slightly recessed and framed with prominent down pipes with decorative hoppers. There are two similarly detailed asymmetrical wings on ether side. The bank has robust vertical decorative brick detailing, Juliet balconies and a prominent stone fascia/band between the ground and first floors.

<u>Townscape</u>: Key landmark. Contributes to local character and street scene.
