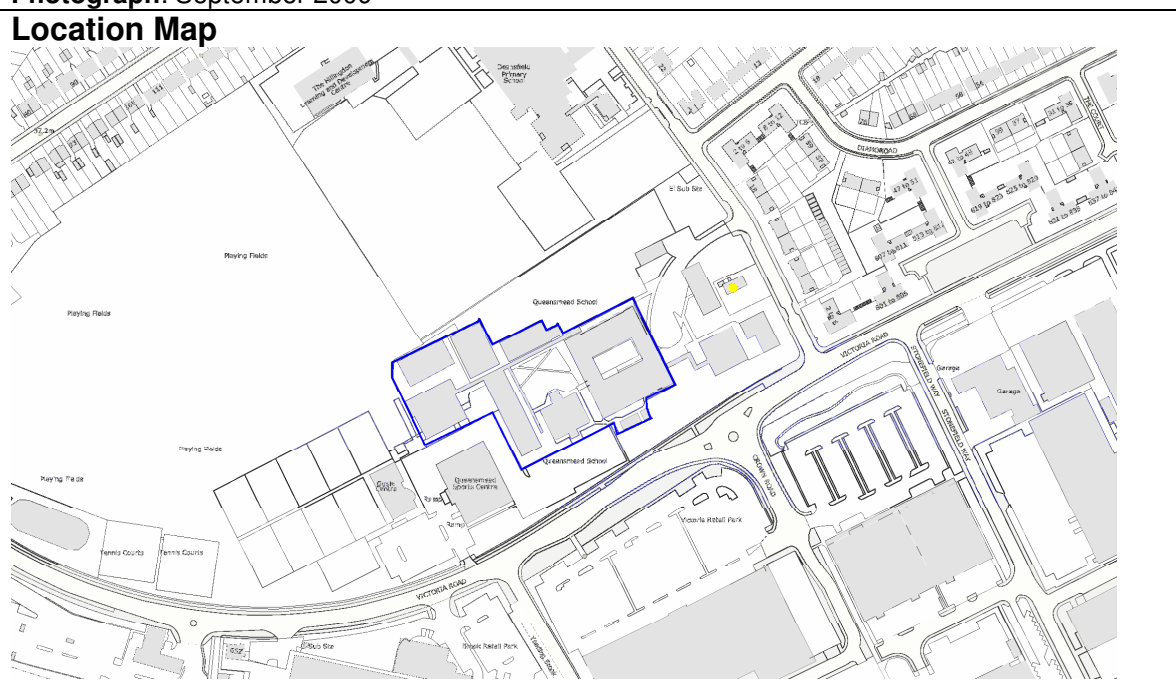

<p>Photograph</p>	<p>Statement of significance/ Reasons for designation</p> <p><u>Architectural</u>: Built as a Secondary Modern in 1968 by Yorke, Rosenberg and Mardall. Set amidst generous playing fields. The hall and administration around a court-yard, but classrooms, gym, workshops etc in separate blocks. Crisply designed, the classrooms in a long range with boarded upper floor on free standing columns.</p> <p><u>Townscape</u>: Key landmark.</p> <p><u>Historic</u>: Planned as a Secondary Modern school. Viewed as a 'school of the future' and advanced ideas of sound proofing, including double glazing were introduced because of the proximity to Northolt Airport.</p>
