Statement of significance/ Reasons for designation

Architectural: 1966-67, by Gerard Goalen. Combination of an oval plan with a visibly rectangular framework. The roof beams project above the clerestory and are supported inside by shuttered concrete columns forming an ambulatory round the western end. The oval stained glass window above and the baptistery windows are by Patrick Reyntiens.

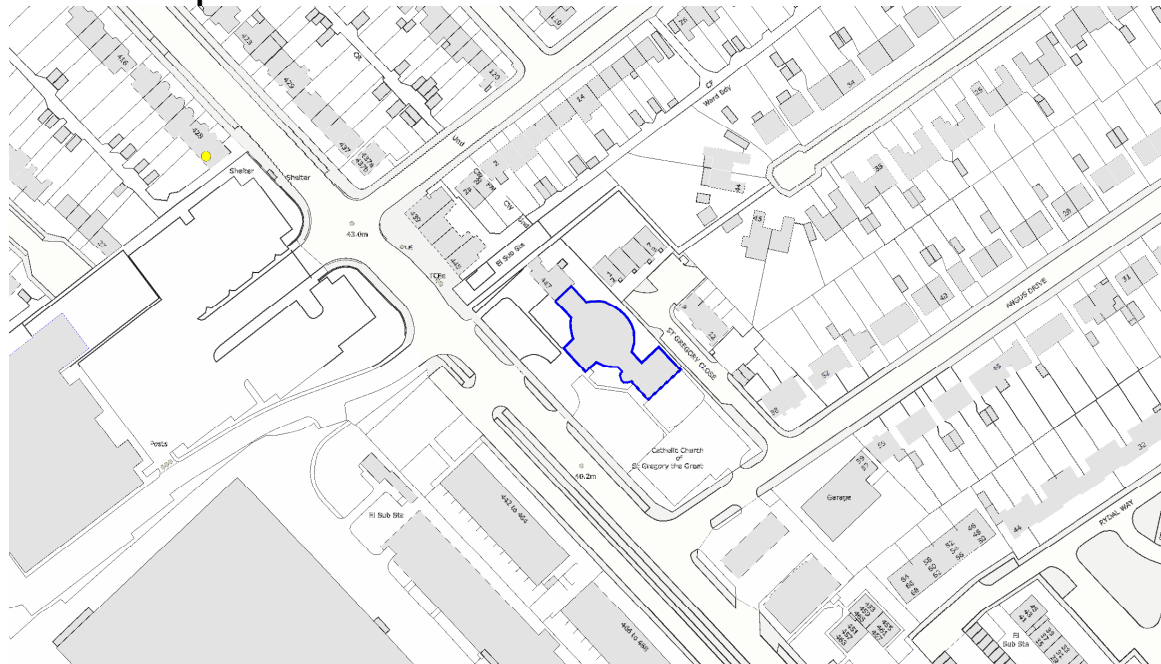
