**Statement of significance/ Reasons for designation**

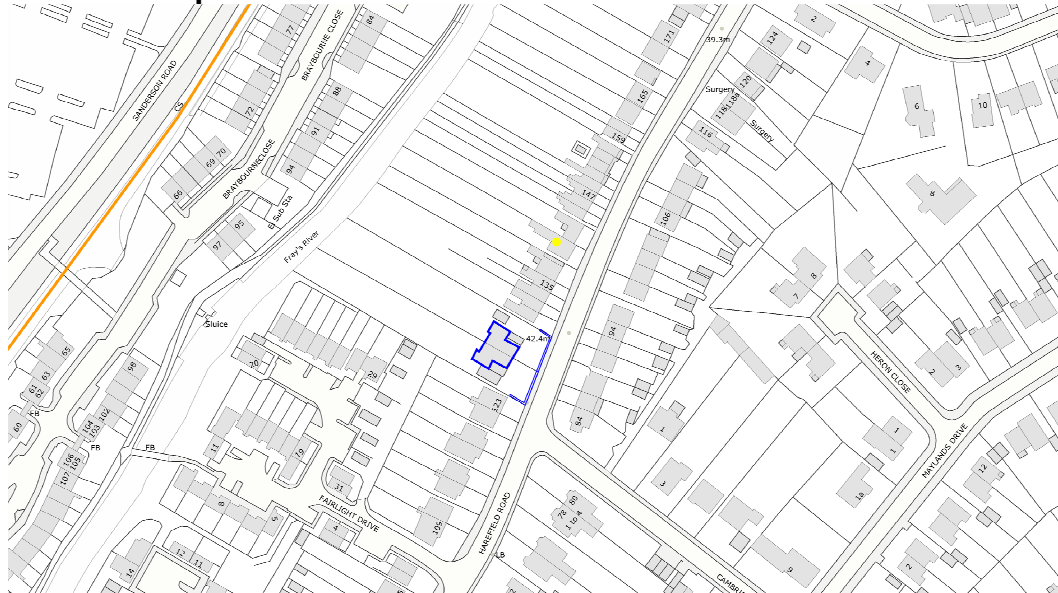
Architecture: Early to mid 19<sup>th</sup> century pair, each two storeys, one window wide with two storey wings under catslide roofs. Yellow stock brick. Hipped slated roof with shared central stack. Pilasters at angles and on axis. Gauged brick arches to sash windows with margin lights. No 125 has one storey entrance extension at left with modern door in glazed porch. No 127 has similar extension holding original door under rectangular fanlight with bars.

Forecourt wall- Low stock brick wall with stone coping, bounded at ends by taller stone coped brick piers. Railing now gone.

Townscape: Contributes to local character and street scene.
