
Statement of significance/

Architectural: Planned from 1970; built in 1973-78. Architects Robert Mathew, Johnson Marshall and Partners. Described as an example of "Romantic Pragmatism", marked a turning point in

the C20 approach to civic buildings. Acknowledging the traditional desire to express the identity of a newly formed authority while rejecting the language previously used by such buildings. Superficially reminiscent of a formalized hill village of suburban brick houses cluttering around an outsize barn. Spaciousness in a generous plaza. Abundance of surface detail and the various projecting staircases obscure what is basically a straight forward plan. Brick, with sweeping hipped tile roof.

<u>Townscape</u>: Occupies the whole of the area between southern end of the High Street and the ring road. Key landmark Historic: Community associations.
