Reasons for designation**

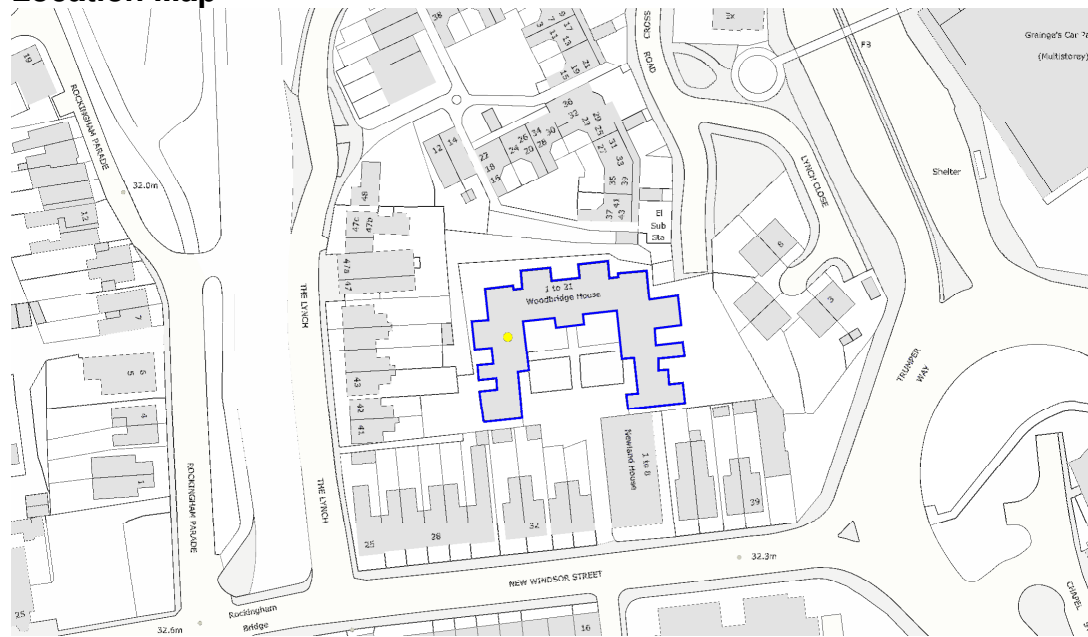
Architectural: Replacement Almshouses built by the Uxbridge United Charities in 1908. The style is “Garden Suburb”, relaxed and simple. A quiet courtyard surrounded by cottage-style residences. Two storeys in white render and mock timber frame

gables. Tiled roof with tall brick chimneys with quoins. Overhanging eaves with oculus. Casement windows with cill and lintel details.

Townscape: Built in the Garden suburb style.
