Statement of significance/ Reasons for designation

Architectural: 1925, Designed by Architect A Gilpin. T-shaped plan form, these are three-storey blocks, arranged as two rows of five, one row on the north and one on the south side of the parade ground. The entrance elevation of a pair face each other except for the first one in a row which faces west onto Hillingdon Road.

Townscape: Group of RAF buildings, comprising of 12 buildings grouped around the main Parade ground, facing Hillingdon Road. All but one to be redeveloped as part of RAF proposals.

Historical: Associated with the Battle of Britain.
