
Statement of significance/ Reasons for designation

Architectural: 1932. Two storey, with an L shaped plan form and having a single storey annexe attached to the south wing. Front elevation symmetrical with a pair of bay windows that form a central entrance and loggia with slightly projecting wings, having a lower roof that cuts that main one at right angles.

<u>Historical</u>: Built to accommodate the matron, sisters and nursing staff working in the adjacent Officers' Hospital. Associated with the Battle of Britain and the military history of Uxbridge.
