Statement of significance/ Reasons for designation

Architectural: 23rd April, 1958. A Cornish granite boulder memorial stone and plaque was unveiled by Lord Dowding, adjacent to the main entrance to the underground operation room.

Historical: The memorial was made by the local monumental masons and sculptors, Henry Wilson (Uxbridge) Ltd. Associated with the Battle of Britain and the military history of Uxbridge.
