Reasons for designation**

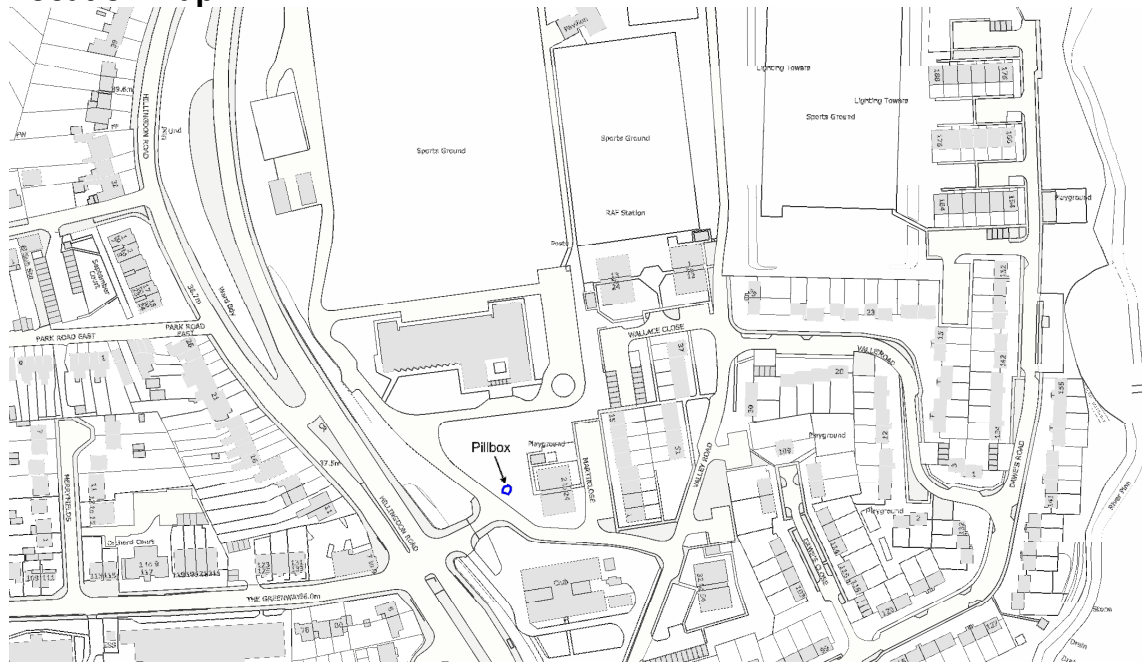
Architectural: Modern pillbox, constructed from pre-cast concrete pipes. Internal diameter 5ft 10in and wall thickness is 4 ¾ in. Consists of concrete plinth, three pipes forming the wall and a roof slab plus a half-pipe protecting the entrance.

Historical: Associated with the Battle of Britain and the military history of Uxbridge.
