Statement of significance/ Reasons for designation

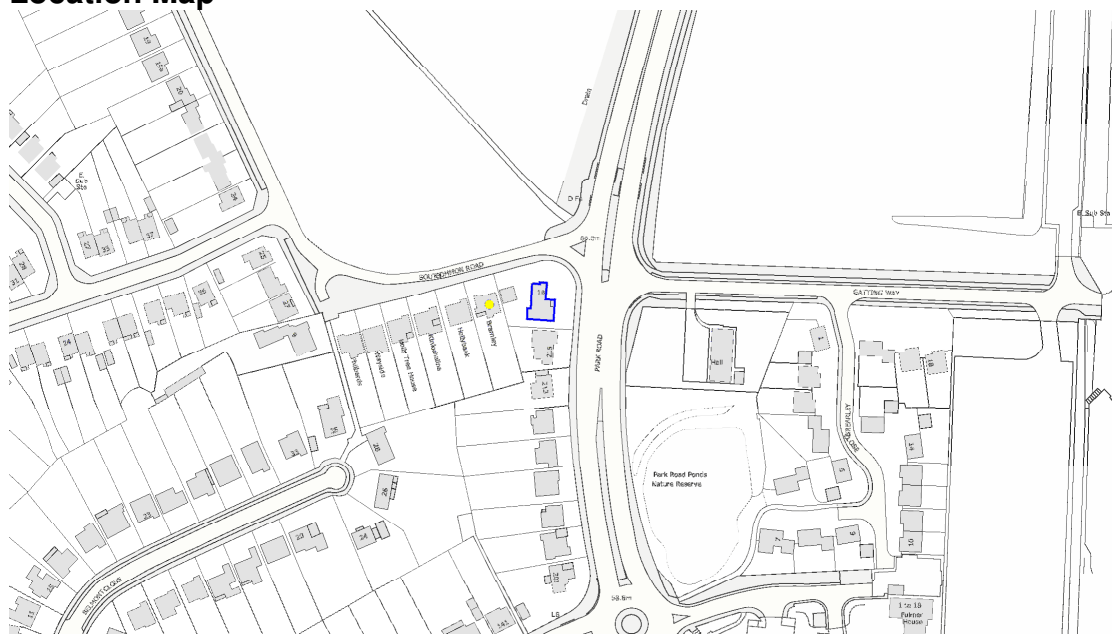
Architecture: Substantial early 20th C house with a later single storey side addition. In white render with hipped green pantile roof. Attractive arched windows to ground floor windows and door with cornices, key stones and pilasters. Louvers to first floor windows retained.

Townscape: Prominent location on Park Road.

Historic: The round headed arches with keystone faces have been reinstated from the Victorian Belmont House that was demolished in the early 1930's.
