Statement of significance/ Reasons for designation

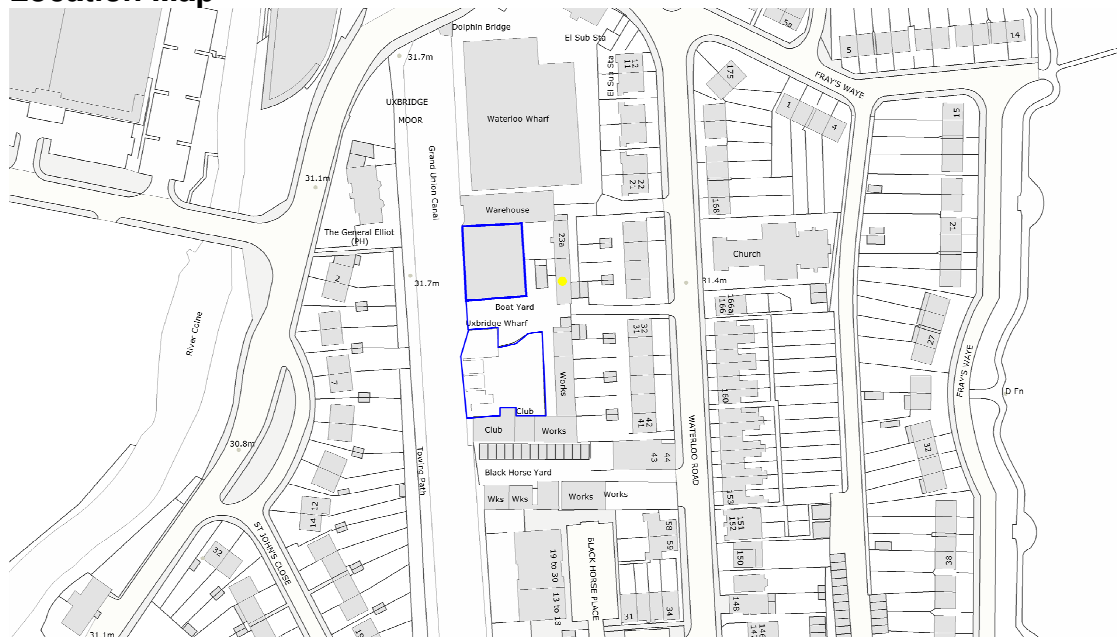
Architectural: Formerly Fellows, Morton and Clayton, canal carriers, with dry dock and an open-sided boat building shed. Circa 1880s, with iron-trussed timber roof-beams of a full 80ft span, allowing narrow boats to be launched sideways into the canal.

Townscape: Group Value with Listed General Elliot P.H opposite. Key Landmark on the Grand Union.

Historic: Important in the context of the industrial archaeology of the Canal.
