Statement of significance/ Reasons for designation

<u>Architectural</u>: Formerly Fellows, Morton and Clayton, canal carriers, with dry dock and an open-sided boat building shed. Circa 1880s, with iron-trussed timber roofbeams of a full 80ft span, allowing narrow boats to be launched sideways into the canal.

<u>Townscape</u>: Group Value with Listed General Elliot P.H opposite. Key Landmark on the Grand Union. <u>Historic</u>: Important in the context of the industrial archaeology of the Canal.
