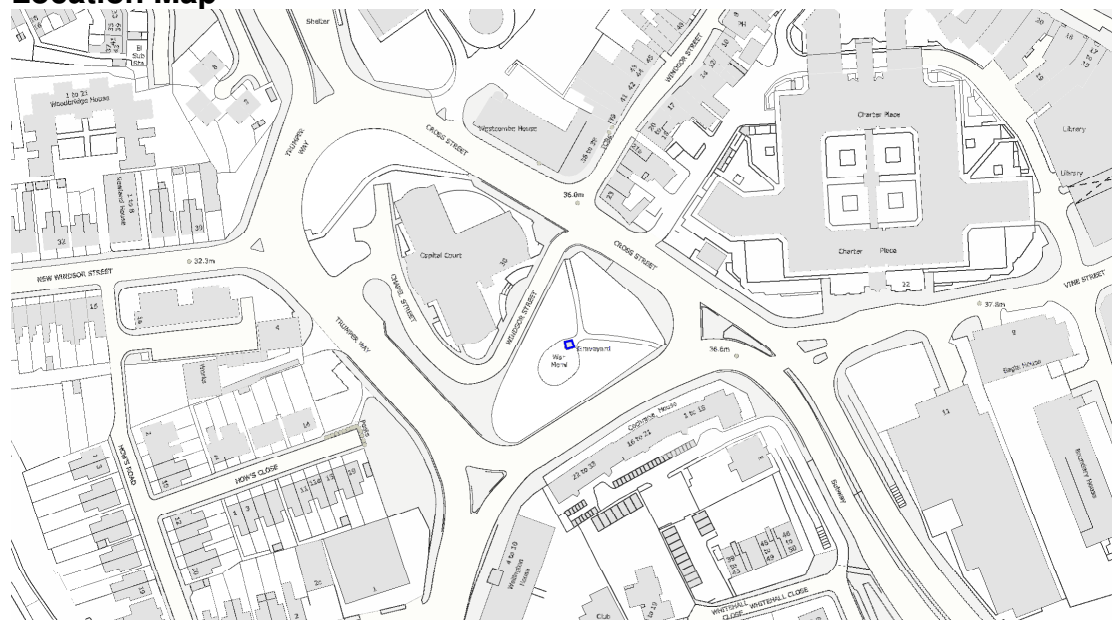
Statement of significance/ Reasons for designation

Architecture: Stone column surmounted by statue of winged angel holding laurel wreath. Octagonal stone base bears inscription- "Erected/ in honour and memory/ of all those/ men and women of Uxbridge who served or fell/ in the great war/ 1914-1918/ an expression of gratitude from/ their fellow townsmen".

Townscape: Key landmark building
Historic: Community Association. First ceremony held 11th Nov, 1924. The monument was moved to its present location in 1970s.
