Statement of significance/ Reasons for designation

Architectural: 1868 by Wilson and Nicholl. Stock brick, with stone tracery. West tower completed in 1985, but without the spire as originally intended. At east end a high level rose window.

Townscape: Contributes to the local character and street scene. Key landmark within The Green.


Historic: Built for Irish immigrants; the foundation stone was laid on 29th Sept, 1868, by the Archbishop of Westminster.
