

### **HOW TO CAST YOUR VOTE**



#### Online

You can vote online using a computer, tablet or a smart phone.

- 1. Go to: www.cesvotes.com/hillingdon
  - You will need your unique security code to log into the site. You can find this on the voting paper.
  - The security code is unique and can only be used once, so don't share it with anyone else.
- 2. Once you have entered the security code click 'Login'.
  - Once you are logged into the voting website you will see the voting instructions.

- Please read the instructions before casting your vote.
- 3. Click the box next to your chosen answer - 'Yes' or 'No'.
- 4. Once you have cast your vote, you will have the opportunity to review and confirm. Check your vote. To change your vote, click 'Previous page'.

If correct, click the 'Submit' button.

By clicking 'Submit' you will have confirmed your vote and it will have been recorded



#### **By post**

Please read the instructions on the ballot paper before casting your vote. Mark a cross (X) in the box next to your chosen answer - 'Yes' or 'No'.

Insert the completed voting paper into the reply pre-paid envelope and place it in a Royal Mail post box.

To ensure your vote is counted, please make sure you post it by Tuesday 18 May at the latest so that it arrives with Civica in time.

#### By telephone

You will need your unique security codes to vote by telephone.

Call the Freephone number listed on your voting paper.

When prompted:

- 1. Press the star \* key
- 2. Enter part one and part two of your security code found on the voting paper.
- 3. Listen carefully to the introduction and question.

When prompted:

- 4. Press 1 to vote 'Yes', or press 2 to vote 'No'
- 5. Press the star \* key to confirm your

You can hang up once your vote has been confirmed.

### SHAPING THE DESIGN OF THE NEW ESTATE

## Did you know that resident feedback has shaped the design proposals?

We have been consulting residents on the design of the new estate and homes since December 2020 and your feedback has helped us make the designs better and more suited to your needs.

We've included a few of the questions you have asked and how our architects have responded here.

### Q Will there be two bedroom apartments with separate kitchen and living rooms?

Yes, we have designed a variety of different layouts for the two bedroom homes, some open plan and some with separate kitchen and living rooms, so there's choice. Three and four bedroom homes will all have separate kitchen and living rooms.

## Q Washing machines can be noisy, especially in open plan living. Can something be done about this?

Yes. We will design the built-in storage cupboards in the hallway so that a washing machine can be installed in them keeping the noise away from bedrooms and living spaces.

## Q Pedestrian only streets on the estate could be places for anti-social behaviour. What can be done to avoid this?

We've redesigned these streets as traditional streets that can be used by cars, cyclists and pedestrians, with parking bays between trees and planting, making them busier places. We have also added more front doors onto the street and plenty of windows overlooking the street to make them feel safe.

## Q Can passers by see into bedrooms on the ground floor?

We have changed the design of homes that are at street level to make sure that bedrooms are all on the first floor.

### Q Will there be fences for the front gardens?

We have included options to enclose front gardens with a wall or railings and will consult with residents on their preferences in the next stage of consultation.

Much more design work needs to be done. If residents vote 'YES' for redevelopment then we will be working closely with you on the designs over the summer and autumn.

#### Did you know?

Residents moving into a new home on the estate can choose from a range of different colours and finishes for their new kitchen cupboards, worktops, bathroom border tiles, walls and floors.
