### **NEXT STEPS**

The next step for the project team is to present the proposals and result to the Council's Cabinet on 17 June with the aim to submit a planning application later this year so that we can begin the first phase of demolition in autumn 2022.

Most importantly, we will be hosting regular drop-in surgeries for residents, particularly those in the first phase of the demolition, to get one-to-one advice.

- For tenants in the first phase, we will be getting in touch with you to begin to formally assess your housing needs in preparation for moving. We are committed to working with residents to find a temporary or permanent move that they are happy with, and the aim is to find something suitable for everyone in phase one between July 2021 and June 2022.
- If you are a tenant in a later phase that is eligible for a new home on the estate, please be reassured that although we cannot guarantee it, we will be looking to accelerate your move to one of the new homes where we can.

We are also aware that some tenants in later phases that are eligible for a new home on the estate are **overcrowded** and concerned about the length of time they might need to wait for one of the new homes to be built. We would like to reassure these tenants that we will prioritise any empty properties that

become available on the

 For resident leaseholders, we will be in touch to begin discussions about the purchase of your property. Again, we will focus on those in the first demolition phase but we will also undertake valuations and purchase any resident leaseholder's property if they want to move early.

We hope to start these in June with an event on the estate for all residents to catch up with the team and architects, learn more about what happens next, and enjoy fun activities for adults and children – more details to follow soon.

We will also be starting to speak to the wider community about the proposed designs and what it might mean for them, including neighbours, businesses and religious groups.

This will be an exciting opportunity for residents to continue to influence the design of the new neighbourhood and homes and we hope you will get involved.
