- iii) Remove part of the Zone E2 parking place outside No. 27 Sunningdale Avenue, Eastcote and replace with 'Monday to Saturday 9am to 5pm' waiting restrictions.
- iv) Remove part of the Zone E2 parking place outside No. 29 Sunningdale Avenue, Eastcote and replace with 'Monday to Saturday 9am to 5pm' waiting restrictions.



SCHEDULE 2

RESIDENT PERMIT HOLDERS PARKING PLACES - ZONE E2

In relation to the parking place referred to in this schedule, the expression "permitted hours," means the period between 'Monday to Saturday 9am to 5pm' inclusive, any such day not being Christmas Day, Good Friday or a Bank Holiday. Parking places in which a vehicle may be left during the permitted hours if it displays a valid Zone E2 permit or visitor voucher. All parking places are 2 metres wide unless otherwise stated.

Parking Place No.	Designated Parking Place
4	SUNNINGDALE AVENUE, The southeast side, from a point 4.2 metres northeast of the southwestern boundary of No. 1 Sunningdale Avenue to a point 10 metres southwest of the southwestern kerbline of Newnham Avenue.
