Resident design consultation

Thank you to everyone who attended the recent design consultation which was held on Tuesday 27 July. We hope you enjoyed the day and found it useful.

It was great to speak to residents and get your feedback on the latest plans for the estate.



The architects presented some 3D models of the new homes and spoke to residents about what the new estate may look like, their preferred materials, and the design of balconies and the shared entrances. We also enjoyed hearing from younger residents about what the new children's play area should look like.

Key topics discussed with residents were the appearance of the new buildings, the layout of the new homes and the new streets and outdoor spaces.

Residents felt that alternatives to red brick should be explored.

There was a wide range of opinions on the design of balconies – some wanted more open, others liked closed, whilst some wanted a mix.

Most residents we spoke to said they liked the idea of large and/or **full height windows**, whilst a few raised the topic of having **spaces to dry clothes**, particularly in the winter months.

Many residents wanted to know more details about the new homes, particularly the size of rooms. The architects are currently working on the **detailed design of the first phase**, plus **sketch designs for future phases**, so that residents can better understand the size and arrangement of rooms, private outdoor space and shared facilities.

Stay in touch

We are continuing to hold surgeries in the **Resident Room** on the estate **every Wednesday** and **Thursday** between **10am-12 noon** and **2-4pm** to answer any questions you may have about the redevelopment process.

We also spoke to some residents about what floor level different rooms are on in the duplex homes and are exploring different options for this.

The topic of **trees and planting** was discussed with some residents, including the potential for planting trees on private terraces or the courtyard gardens, and we are keen to learn more about what sort of planting residents want to see in the gardens.

The recent warm weather prompted some residents to ask about **air conditioning**. This won't be provided but we will be looking carefully at insulation and shading to prevent the new homes getting too hot or too cold.

Finally, we spoke about the new community room on the estate and look forward to hearing more ideas from residents about how this could be used.

Next resident design consultation

We want to continue to speak to residents about the design proposals for the new homes, landscaping, play areas, and courtyards.

The architects are busy developing the designs for phase one in more detail, taking on board your feedback, and we will be hosting further consultations soon.
