



#### STATEMENT OF REASONS

The removal of the width restriction will allow possible future bus route opportunities between Hayes Town and the Southall Waterside (the former Gas Works) development. There is already a 7.5t vehicle weight limit in force on part of Pump Lane, Hayes preventing HGV movements, therefore the width restriction is now longer required.

#### THE HILLINGDON (SPEED LIMIT) (NO.) TRAFFIC ORDER 2021

Hillingdon Council gives notice that it proposes to make this Order to:

1. Revoke the existing 50mph speed limit on Ducks Hill Road, Northwood/Ruislip and replace with:

i) An extension of the existing 30mph speed limit, between point 21 metres northwest of the southeastern flank wall of the Arens Bar to a point 20 metres north of the northern boundary of Arens Bar.

ii) A new 40mph speed limit from a point 20 metres north of the northern boundary of Arens Bar, to a point 34.8 metres southeast of the southeastern flank wall of Wynlie House.

**2.** Revoke a section of the existing 40mph speed limit on Breakspear Road North, Harefield and replace with a new 30mph speed limit from a point 32 metres southeast of the common boundary of No. 7 Breakspear Road North and Farm View, Breakspear Road North, to a point 45.5 metres southeast of the southeastern boundary of Tarleton Lodge.

**3. Extend the existing 20mph speed limit on Breakspear Road North, Harefield,** near the junction with Northwood Road southeastwards to a point 32 metres southeast of the common boundary of No. 7 Breakspear Road North and Farm View, Breakspear Road North.

**4. Introduce a 30 mph speed limit throughout Newyears Green Lane, Harefield** to replace the current national speed limit.

**5.** Introduce a **30** mph speed limit on the section Shrubs Road, Harefield within the London Borough of Hillingdon to replace the current national speed limit.

**6. Revoke the existing 40mph speed limit on Northwood Road, Harefield** and replace with a new 30mph speed limit, from a point 15 metres southwest of the northeastern boundary of Little Acres, Northwood Road, to a point in line with the borough boundary with Three Rivers District Council. 

#### STATEMENT OF REASONS



Breakspear Road North map illustrating locations for new speed reduction signpost and slow road markings.






Ducks Hill Road map illustrating locations for new speed reduction signpost and slow road markings.





Newyears Green Lane map illustrating locations for new speed reduction signpost and roundel markings.






The Council of the London Borough of Hillingdon in exercise of its powers under Section 84 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (as amended by the Local Government Act 1985) and all other powers thereunto enabling hereby make the following Order after consulting the Commissioner of Police of the Metropolis and with the consent of the Secretary of State for Transport; hereby make the following Order:-

- (1) This Order shall come into operation on the ????????? and may be cited as the London Borough of Hillingdon (Speed Limit) (No. ??) Traffic Order 2021.
- This Order revokes the provisions of The Hillingdon (Speed Limit) (No. 1) Traffic Order 2021, The Hillingdon (40 MPH Speed Limit) (No. 1) Traffic Order 2014, The Hillingdon (50 MPH Speed Limit) (No. 1) Traffic Order 2011, The Hillingdon (20 MPH Speed Limit) (No. 1) Traffic Order 2006 and The Hillingdon (40 M.P.H. Speed Limit) (No. 1) Traffic Order 2005.
- (3) No person shall cause or permit any vehicle to proceed at a speed exceeding 20 mph on the lengths of road listed in Schedule 1 to this Order.
- (4) No person shall cause or permit any vehicle to proceed at a speed exceeding 30 mph on the lengths of road listed in Schedule 2 to this Order.
- (5) No person shall cause or permit any vehicle to proceed at a speed exceeding 30 mph on the lengths of road listed in Schedule 2 to this Order.

(6) No speed limit imposed by this Order applies to vehicles falling within regulation 3(4) of the Road Traffic Exemptions (Special Forces) (Variation and Amendment) Regulations 2011 when used in accordance with regulation 3(5) of those Regulations.

#### SCHEDULE 1 - 20MPH SPEED LIMIT

PARK LANE, HAREFIELD - Between the southeastern kerbline of the High Street, Harefield and a point in line with the eastern boundary of The Old Stables, Park Lane.

RICKMANSWORTH ROAD, HAREFIELD - Between the southwestern kerbline of Breakspear Road North and the southwestern kerbline of Vernon Drive;

BREAKSPEAR ROAD NORTH, HAREFIELD - From a point 11 metres southeast of the southeastern kerbline of Northwood Road, to a point 32 metres southeast of the common boundary of No. 7 Breakspear Road North and Farm View, Breakspear Road North.

POND CLOSE, HAREFIELD – The entire road.

#### SCHEDULE 2 - 30MPH SPEED LIMIT

BREAKSPEAR ROAD, RUISLIP – The entire road, between the junctions with Bury Street and Breakspear Road South.

BREAKSPEAR ROAD NORTH, HAREFIELD – From a point in line with the northern kerbline of Fine Bush Lane, northwards for a distance of 15 metres.

BREAKSPEAR ROAD NORTH, HAREFIELD - From a point 32 metres southeast of the common boundary of No. 7 Breakspear Road North and Farm View, Breakspear Road North, to a point 45.5 metres southeast of the southeastern boundary of Tarleton Lodge.

BREAKSPEAR ROAD SOUTH, ICKENHAM – The entire road, between the junction with Swakeleys Road and the northern kerbline of Fine Bush Lane, Ruislip

DUCKS HILL ROAD, RUISLIP – Between where the road meets the junction with Bury Street, to a point 20 metres north of the northern boundary of Arens Bar.

FINE BUSH LANE, RUISLIP – The entire road, between the junctions with Breakspear Road and Breakspear Road South.

HARVIL ROAD, ICKENHAM – From a point in line with the northwestern kerbline of Swakeleys Road, to a point 10.9 metres south of the northern boundary of No. 2 Harvil Farm, Harvil Road.

NEWYEARS GREEN LANE, HAREFIELD – The entire road.

NORTHWOOD ROAD, HAREFIELD - From a point 20 metres north of the northern boundary of Arens Bar, to a point 34.8 metres southeast of the southeastern flank wall of Wynlie House.

SHRUBS ROAD, HAREFIELD – The entire extent of the road within the London Borough of Hillingdon.

### SCHEDULE 3 - 40MPH SPEED LIMIT

BREAKSPEAR ROAD NORTH, HAREFIELD - From a point 15 metres north of the northern kerbline of Fine Bush Lane, to a point 45.5 metres southeast of the southeastern boundary of Tarleton Lodge..

HARVIL ROAD, HAREFIELD & ICKENHAM - From a point 10.9 metres south of the northern boundary of No. 2 Harvil Farm, Harvil Road, to a point 75 metres south-east of the south-eastern boundary of No. 31 Harvil Road, Harefield.

DUCKS HILL ROAD, NORTHWOOD / RUISLIP - From a point 20 metres north of the northern boundary of Arens Bar, to a point 34.8 metres southeast of the southeastern flank wall of Wynlie House.
