 - v) Outside No. 41 Melrose Close, Hayes
 - vi) Outside No. 106 West End Road, Ruislip
 - vii) Outside No. 23 Botwell Crescent, Hayes
 - viii) Outside No. 43 St Dunstans Close, Hayes
- 3. Convert a section of Zone WD1 permit holder parking place outside No. 2 Bellclose Road, West Drayton to a blue badge disabled parking bay.
- 4. Remove the following redundant disabled parking bays at the following locations:
 - i) Outside No. 26 Wesley Road, Hayes
 - ii) Outside No. 33 Manningtree Road, Ruislip
 - iii) Outside No. 82 Petworth Gardens, Hillingdon
 - iv) Outside No. 6 Cromwell Road, Hayes
- 5. Convert the section of existing 'Monday to Friday 9am to 5pm' waiting restrictions on Glebe Avenue, Ickenham opposite the junction with Sussex Road to 'at any time' waiting restrictions.






STATEMENT OF REASONS


The proposed installation of waiting restrictions are intended to remove obstructive parking to assist the free flow of traffic and promote road safety. All proposals have been agreed in principle by the Cabinet Member for Public Safety and Transport to proceed to formal consultation.

The proposed disabled parking bays are intended to benefit disabled people by providing parking bays for the sole use of "blue badge" holders. Redundant bays will be removed to provide more parking for residents and their visitors.




























