

Hillingdon at a glance, 2017

- Population comparing the 2011 Census figures with those with GLA Interim 2015-based population projections, the borough's population in 2017 has increased by approximately 10.9% (from 273,936 to 303,870); by comparison London's population has increased by 8.5%. Over half of Hillingdon's 44.6 square miles is a mosaic of countryside including canals, rivers, parks and woodland. Hillingdon has an average of 25.9 people per hectare; this is the third lowest population density among London boroughs.
- **Gender** 152,246 of borough residents are male and 151,624 are female.
- **Age** 21.7% of the borough population is under 16, 6.1% over 75 and 72.1% aged 16-74 (this is defined as working age).
- **Ethnicity** Hillingdon's White British population decreased from 73% in the 2001 Census to 52% in the 2011 Census; Hillingdon's BAME population increased from 27% to 48% in the same period. Current data (from the Greater London Authority 2015 Round Trend-based Ethnic Group Population Projections) shows that Hillingdon's White British population in 2017 is 43% and the BAME population is 57%.
- **Religion**¹ the predominant religions in the borough at 2011 are Christian 134,813 (49.2%), Muslim 29,065 (10.6%), Hindu 22,033 (8.0%) and Sikh 18,230 (6.7%), we also have a large percentage of residents stating 'no religion' 46,492 (17.0%) and other 23,303 (8.5%).




Uxbridge & West Drayton locality

Uxbridge & West Drayton locality lies in the centre of Hillingdon and is made up of 7 wards. It is bordered by South Bucks.

In 2017², the locality population is 101,956 residents, an increase of 11,446 (12.6%) since 2011 (90,510); this is higher than the 10.9% increase for Hillingdon overall. The locality is made up of 2,833.1 hectares (28.3 km^{sq}), with 36.0 people per hectare (3,598 per km^{sq}). The average number of people per household is 2.6³.

Deprivation

The 2015 Indices of Multiple Deprivation (IMD) calculate local measures of deprivation and indicates where each small area is ranked in relation to the whole of England. The map below shows patterns of deprivation within Hillingdon⁴. Hillingdon has no LSOAs in the most deprived decile.



The chart above shows that 19.8% of Uxbridge & West Drayton residents are under the age of 16. 74.4% of residents fall into the working age bracket (defined as a resident aged between 16 and 74) and the remaining 5.8% are over the age of 75.

The chart below shows that in Uxbridge & West Drayton there are higher numbers of males and females in the 20-24 age brackets when compared to other age groups.




Gender

The proportion of **men to women** in the locality is 50.5% to 49.5%. This is a small change from 2011 when there was a 49.8% to 50.2% male to female ratio in the locality.

Male/Female ratio at borough, locality and ward level, 2017





Ethnic make up 2011⁵


In the 2011 census, 67.2% of Uxbridge & West Drayton residents identified themselves as White British background (this includes English, Northern Irish, Scottish, Welsh, Irish, Gypsy or Irish Traveller and Other White). 3.9 % from Mixed / Multiple Ethnic groups, 19.8% from Asian / Asian British background (including Indian, Pakistani, Bangladeshi and Chinese), 3.9% from Black / African / Caribbean / Black British backgrounds and 2.9% from other ethnic backgrounds (including Arab).

Hillingdon, Ethnic makeup 2011:





Religion⁶


Christianity is the predominant religion in the locality with 51.9% from this faith. 5.4% are Hindu, 9.1% are Muslim and 21.3% have no religion, 4.1% are Sikhs and 6.6% chose not to state a religion (the question was voluntary).

Uxbridge & West Drayton, Religion 2011:




Hillingdon, Religion 2011:

Country of Birth⁷

Of those living in Uxbridge & West Drayton, 81.3% were **born** in Europe (with 74.1% in the UK), 12.0% in the Middle East / Asia, 5.1% in Africa, and 1.6% in the Americas, Caribbean or Australasia. In the locality, 25.9% were **born** outside of the UK (with 74.1% in the UK).

The preferred **language** in the locality is English with 84.6% residents stating this as their main language. Of the remaining 15.4% the majority speak English 'very well' or 'well'; 1,879 residents (14.0%) stated they cannot speak English well or at all⁸.


Apart from English, the most spoken languages in the locality are Panjabi (1,492 residents, 1.7%) and Polish (1,173 residents, 1.4%).

In Uxbridge & West Drayton, the working age population of those in the age bracket 16-24 make up 22.2% of the ward population, whilst the 25-59 age group make up 63.8%, the remaining 14.0% are from the 60-74 age group.





The chart below shows income deprivation being varied across Hillingdon. In Uxbridge & West Drayton, the percentage of people who live in income deprived households ranges from 4.8% in Ickenham to 19.2% in West Drayton and Yiewsley. The majority of wards in the locality are below the England and Hillingdon average, however Yiewsley and West Drayton are both above.

Households

In 2017, there were 39,545 households¹⁰ in Uxbridge & West Drayton locality; an increase of 5,488 since Census 2011. The majority of **housing type**¹¹ within the locality is houses or bungalows (either detached, semi or terraced) at 74.1%, with 25.9% being flats or maisonettes (including those in a commercial building).





In Uxbridge & West Drayton, 61.8% of locality residents own their own homes, followed by 18.0% of properties being privately rented, 17.8% socially rented from the Council and the remaining residents make up 2.4% other (eg shared ownership, living rent free).


Household Type Uxbridge & West Drayton





Health

Life expectancy is the number of years a person is expected to live on average. Within Uxbridge & West Drayton, the ward of Ickenham has the highest life expectancy for both males and females. Across all wards within the locality, females have a higher life expectancy than males.


Observed Prevalence

These graphs show the recorded prevalence of long term conditions from the Quality & Outcomes Framework (QOF) 2017/18, at GP practice level. They show the calculated prevalence of patients on a GP register, recorded as having a given condition. The graphs show recorded prevalence at England, London, borough and locality level. Uxbridge & West Drayton contains 14 GP surgeries.






Atrial Fibrilation prevalence, 2017/18










Dementia prevalence, 2017/18















Diabetes prevalence, 2017/18





Estimated Prevalence


The estimated prevalence is the number of patients who may have a condition but who have not been diagnosed.

Uxbridge & West Drayton contains 14 GP surgeries. As before, patients registered with these GP practices do not necessarily live in the ward or borough.


Diagnosed Hypertension










Estimated prevalence of Stroke, Uxbridge & West Drayton 2015
