

Hillingdon at a glance, 2017

- Population comparing the 2011 Census figures with those with GLA Interim 2015-based population projections, the borough's population in 2017 has increased by approximately 10.9% (from 273,936 to 303,870); by comparison London's population has increased by 8.5%. Over half of Hillingdon's 44.6 square miles is a mosaic of countryside including canals, rivers, parks and woodland. Hillingdon has an average of 25.9 people per hectare; this is the third lowest population density among London boroughs.
- **Gender** 152,246 of borough residents are male and 151,624 are female.
- **Age** 21.7% of the borough population is under 16, 6.1% over 75 and 72.1% aged 16-74 (this is defined as working age).
- Ethnicity Hillingdon's White British population decreased from 73% in the 2001 Census to 52% in the 2011 Census; Hillingdon's BAME population increased from 27% to 48% in the same period. Current data (from the Greater London Authority 2015 Round Trend-based Ethnic Group Population Projections) shows that Hillingdon's White British population in 2017 is 43% and the BAME population is 57%.
- Religion¹ the predominant religions in the borough at 2011 are Christian 134,813 (49.2%), Muslim 29,065 (10.6%), Hindu 22,033 (8%) and Sikh 18,230 (6.7%), we also have a large percentage of residents stating 'no religion' 46,492 (17%) and other 23,303 (8.5%).


Charville Ward

Charville lies in the centre of Hillingdon and is bordered by Hillingdon East, Barnhill and Botwell, as well as the London Borough of Ealing.

In 2017², Charville population is 13,119 residents, an increase of 3.9% since 2011 (12,622); this is below the 10.9% increase for Hillingdon overall. Charville is made up of 297.3 hectares (3.0 km^{sq}), with 44.1 people per hectare (4,413 per km^{sq}). The average number of people per household in Charville is 2.9³.

Deprivation

The 2015 Indices of Multiple Deprivation (IMD) calculates local measures of deprivation and indicates where each small area is ranked in relation to the whole of England. The map below shows patterns of deprivation within Charville, which is made up of eight LSOA areas⁴.





Ward Population:



The chart above shows that 22.4% of Charville residents are under the age of 16. 71.0% of residents fall into the working age bracket (defined as a resident aged between 16 and 74) and the remaining 6.6% are over the age of 75.

The chart below shows that in Charville, there are higher numbers of males aged 20-24. However, the number of females is higher in the 50-54 age bracket compared to other age groups.




Gender

The proportion of men to women in the ward is 50.1% to 49.9%. This is a small change from 2011 when there was a 50.0% to 50.0% male to female ratio in the ward.


Male/Female ratio at Hillingdon and ward level, 2017




Ethnic make up 2011⁵

In Charville, 56.1% of the ward residents identified themselves in the 2011 census as White British background (this includes English, Northern Irish, Scottish, Welsh, Irish, Gypsy or Irish Traveller and Other White). 3.9% from Mixed / Multiple Ethnic groups, 27.0% from Asian / Asian British background (including Indian, Pakistani, Bangladeshi and Chinese), 9.4% from Black / African / Caribbean / Black British backgrounds and 3.5% from other ethnic backgrounds (including Arab).

Hillingdon, Ethnic makeup 2011:





Religion⁶


In Charville, Christianity is the predominant religion in the ward with 49.6% from this faith. 11.5% Muslim, 9.8% are Hindu, 8.4% Sikh with 14.1% having no religion. 5.5% chose not to state a religion (the question was voluntary).

Charville, Religion 2011:




Hillingdon, Religion 2011:

Country of Birth⁷

Of those living in Charville, 76.9% of were **born** in Europe (with 69.9% in the UK), 15.4% in the Middle East / Asia, 5.8% in Africa, and 1.8% in the Americas, Caribbean or Australasia. In Charville, 30.1% were **born** outside of the UK (with 69.9% in the UK).

The preferred **language** in Charville is English, with 80.5% of residents stating it as their main language; of the remaining 19.5% the majority speak English 'very well' or 'well'. 414 residents (17.6% of those where English is not their main language) state that they cannot speak English well or at all⁸.


Apart from English the most spoken language in the ward are Panjabi (514 residents, 4.3%) and Tamil (401 residents, 3.3%).

In Charville, the working age population of those aged 16-24 make up 18.6%, whilst the 25-59 age group make up 66.7% followed by 14.7% from the 60-74 age group.


In Charville, 70.7% of residents of working age are economically active. The table below provides a breakdown of economic activity in the ward when compared with Hillingdon and England:



The chart below shows income deprivation being varied across Hillingdon. At ward level, the percentage of people who live in income deprived households ranges from 4.8% in Ickenham to 21.7% in Townfield. Charville is 13.6%, which is the same as Hillingdon (13.6%) but lower than England (14.6%).

Households

In 2017, there were 4,535 households¹⁰ in Charville; an increase of 48 since Census 2011. The majority of **housing type**¹¹ within the ward is houses or bungalows (either detached, semi or terraced) at 82.0%, with 18.0% being flats or maisonettes (including those in a commercial building).



In Charville, 71.1% of ward residents are household owned, followed by 15.9% of properties being privately rented, 9.7% socially rented from the Council and the remaining residents make up 3.3% other e.g. share ownership, living rent free.



Health

Life expectancy is the number of years a person is expected to live on average. In Charville, the life expectancy is estimated at 80.4 years for males and 82.9 years for females. This is similar to the averages for Hillingdon and England.




Observed Prevalence¹²

These graphs show the recorded prevalence of long term conditions from the Quality & Outcomes Framework (QOF) 2017/18, at GP practice level. They show the calculated prevalence of patients on a GP register, recorded as having a given condition. It should be noted that patients registered in this ward do not necessarily live in the ward or the Borough.

The graphs show recorded prevalence at England, London, borough, locality and ward level. Charville ward contains 2 GP surgeries (The Pine Medical Centre and The Cedar Brook Practice).



The prevalence of **coronary heart disease** within Charville is 2.17%; this is lower than England and Hillingdon, but higher than London and the locality:










The prevalence of **hypertension** in Charville is 13.21%, which is lower than England, but higher than London, Hillingdon and the locality:




The prevalence of **stroke / transient ischaemic attack (TIA)** is 1.04% which is lower than England, London and Hillingdon, but higher than the locality:



The prevalence of **asthma** within Charville is 5.04% which is lower than England, but higher than London, Hillingdon and the locality:








The prevalence of **depression** within Charville is 8.57%, which is lower than England, but higher than London, Hillingdon and the locality:




The prevalence of **epilepsy** in Charville is 0.68% which is lower than England, but higher than London, Hillingdon and the locality:



The prevalence of **learning disabilities** in Charville is 0.37% which is lower than England and London, similar to Hillingdon, and higher than the locality:





The prevalence of **cancer** in Charville is 1.31% which is lower than England, London and Hillingdon, but higher than the locality:






The prevalence of **diabetes** in Charville is 8.67% which is lower than the locality, but higher than England, London and Hillingdon:







The prevalence of **palliative care** in Charville is 0.19% which is lower than England, London, Hillingdon and the locality:

The estimated prevalence is the number of patients who may have a condition but who have not been diagnosed.



Estimated prevalence is available on a limited number of conditions; data is taken from the latest Disease & Risk Factor Prevalence profile on Fingertips, 2015 (https://fingertips.phe.org.uk/profile/prevalence).

Charville ward contains 2 GP surgeries (Pine Medical Centre and Cedar Brook Practice). As before, patients registered with these GP practices do not necessarily live in the ward or borough.

Pine Medical Centre has the highest estimated prevalence of the 2 surgeries in the ward.







Cedar Brook Practice has the highest estimated prevalence of the 2 surgeries in the ward.



Pine Medical Centre has the highest estimated prevalence of the 2 surgeries in the ward.





Pine Medical Centre has the highest estimated prevalence of the 2 surgeries in the ward.


