School Census 2014: Executive Summary:

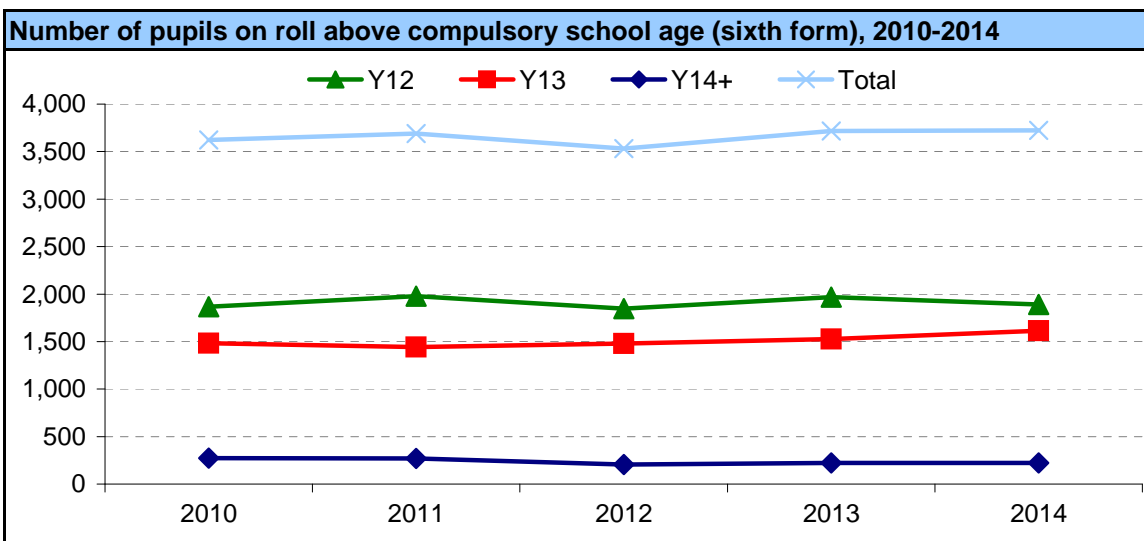
School Census provides, in electronic format, a range of data about each and every pupil in maintained primary, secondary and special school. It is collected every term. This report contains an overview of the position as at 16th January 2014.

Information included in the Executive Summary includes pupil numbers, school population by ethnicity, pupils eligible for free school meals and special educational needs.

There are 48,642 pupils in Hillingdon's 92 state-funded educational establishments. The number of children in maintained Nurseries has fallen by around 100 pupils. Overall, pupils in Hillingdon schools have increased by 1136 (2.4%) pupils compared to 2013.



The number of children in Year 12 in 2014 fell by 4% compared 2013. 56% of Year 11 continue Post 16 studies in Year 12 in 2014. Just over half the children in our Sixth Forms are studying A Levels (this varies considerably from school to school).

Nearly 20% of pupils attending our Sixth Forms live outside the Local Authority but attend Hillingdon schools (Out-Borough pupils). For information: The proportion of Out-Borough pupils in Year 11 in 2013 was 15%. Additional analysis/a breakdown of "Out borough" pupils by academic year group is provided on page 65.

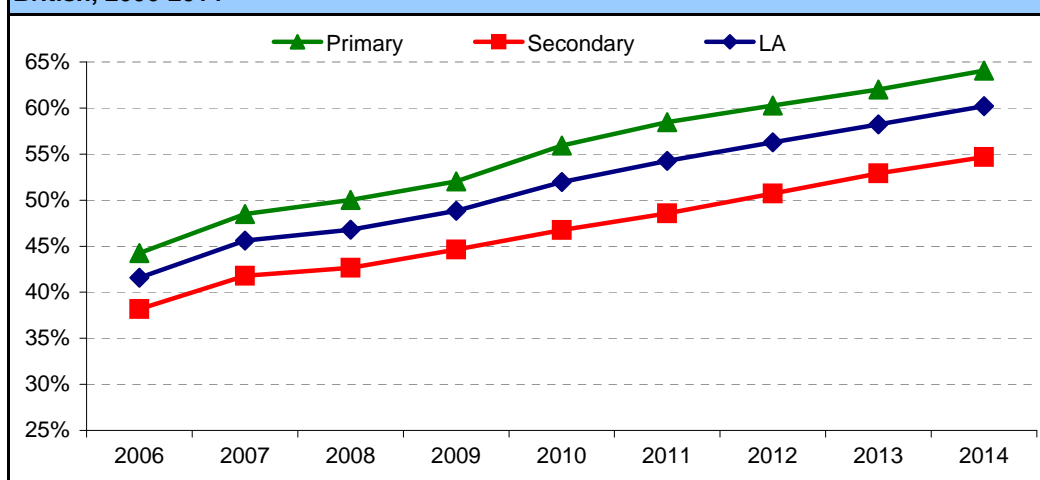

Although the data shows that the percentage of pupils of ethnic heritage other than White British in Hillingdon schools rising and is over 60% (in 2014); there are some miscategorisations under the ethnic group 'Any Other White background', so the proportion of minority ethnic group (other than White British) may not be so high.

The proportion of minority ethnic group (other than White British) is likely to fall (no more than 1%) as schools rectify this problem. Please note: the "Any Other White background" (which is an ethnic minority) is not the same as White British or "Other White British". "Any Other White background" consists of Eastern, Western Europeans and Portuguese pupils (for example). More detail is provided on Page 30. All sub-categorised ethnic origins that fall under the main ethnic group such as "Any other White background" or "White British" etc. are provided in the DfEE guidance.

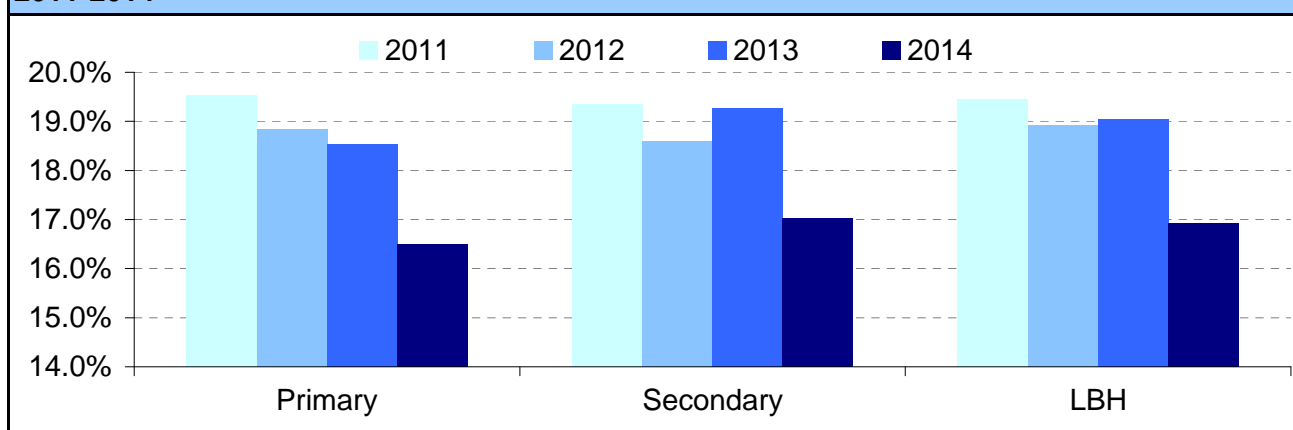
Free School Meals

Percentage of compulsory age school pupils known to be eligible for free school meals, 2011-2014



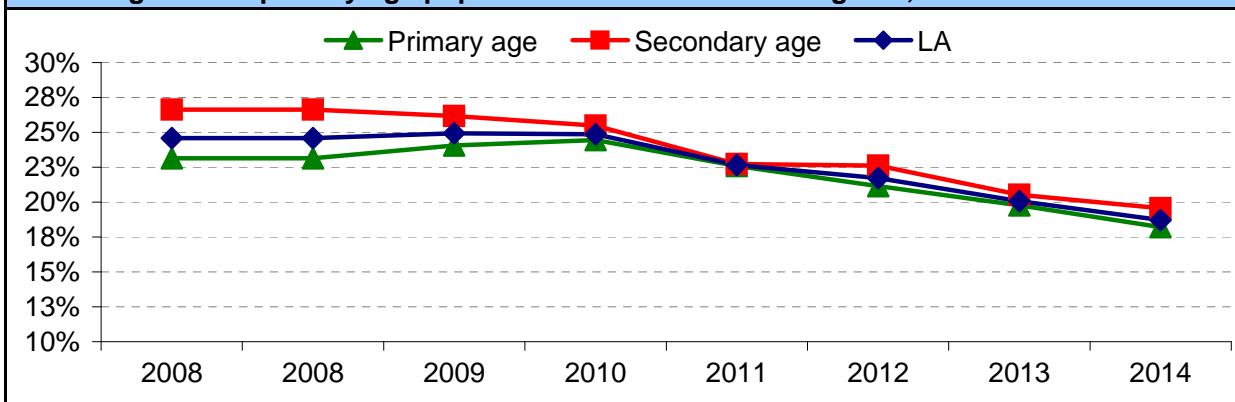
The percentage of pupils known to be eligible for free school meals, the standard measure of deprivation used in education, has dropped significantly in 2014, from 19.0% in 2013 to 16.9% in 2014.

Percentage of compulsory age pupils in all schools on SEN register, 2008-2013

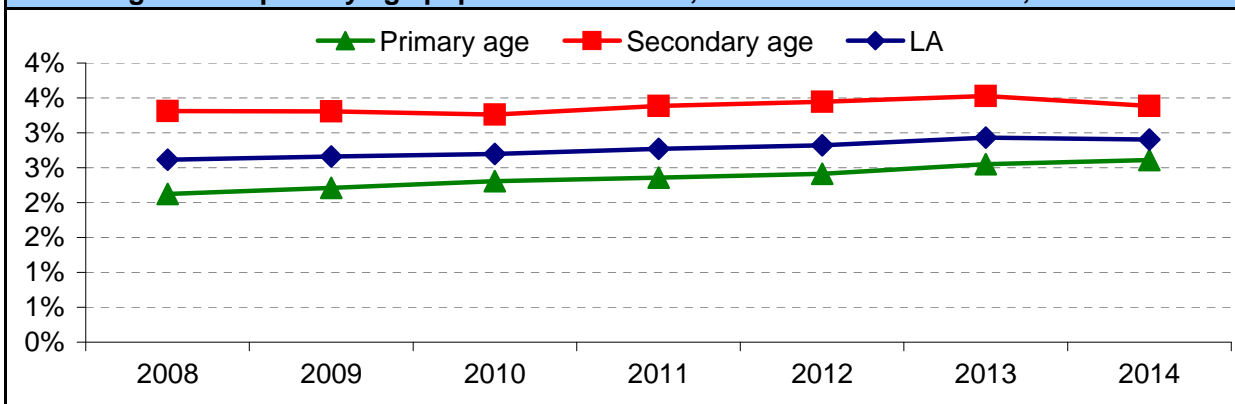


There was a fall in the proportion of compulsory age pupils identified by schools as having special educational needs, falling from 24.6% in 2008 to 18.7% in 2014.

As you can see, the gap between primary and secondary as narrowed significantly over the last 6 years. There was a gap of 3.5% in 2008, this has now 1.3%.

In the primary sector, 18.2% of pupils were recorded as having SEN compared to 19.6% in the secondary sector.

Despite the rise in the identification of special educational needs, the percentage of pupils with a statement of SEN in the LA remains fairly steady. It was 2.6% in 2008 and 2.9% in 2014.

FT =Full-time, PT =Part-time, B= Boys, G =Girls, T= Total boys and girls,

The number contained within the heading refers to age as at 31st August 2013, and corresponds to national curriculum year groups. Although there may be occasions when pupils are placed in year groups above or below the year group they would ordinarily be placed according to age. The table below shows the national curriculum year groups, corresponding date of birth ranges and Key Stages.

Total boys and girls (part time and full time). Pupils below compulsory school age are further subdivided according to the term in which they were born (in order to facilitate the planning of school and nursery places). Columns referring to three and four year olds are suffixed by a letter a, b, c, to denote term of birth as follows:

- a: Autumn born (September to December inclusive)
- b: Spring born (January to March inclusive)
- c. Summer born (April to August inclusive)

Change in Pupil Numbers

The total number of pupils in Hillingdon in January 2014 was 48,642. This represents a 2.3% increase in pupil numbers compared with last years School Census, when the total school population stood at 47,506.

Primary sector pupils make up **59.4%** of the total school population in Hillingdon. Followed by the secondary sector at **39.2%** and the special sector at **1.3%**.

The total number of full-time children in Reception to Year 6 was 24,535 in 2013. This has increased to 25,730 in 2014, a percentage increase of 4.6%. The biggest increase is in Year 1, which increased by 8.6%. This is due to the increase in Reception in 2012-2013 which increased by 7.7% (compared to 3.2% in the previous year). This blip, which represents an increase of an extra 170 pupils will trickle down, will trickle through the year groups.

In the secondary sector, year 7 to 11, the increase was much smaller at 0.1%. There was in fact a 2% drop in the total number of children in Year 7. The overall increase including Post 16 children is 0.4%.

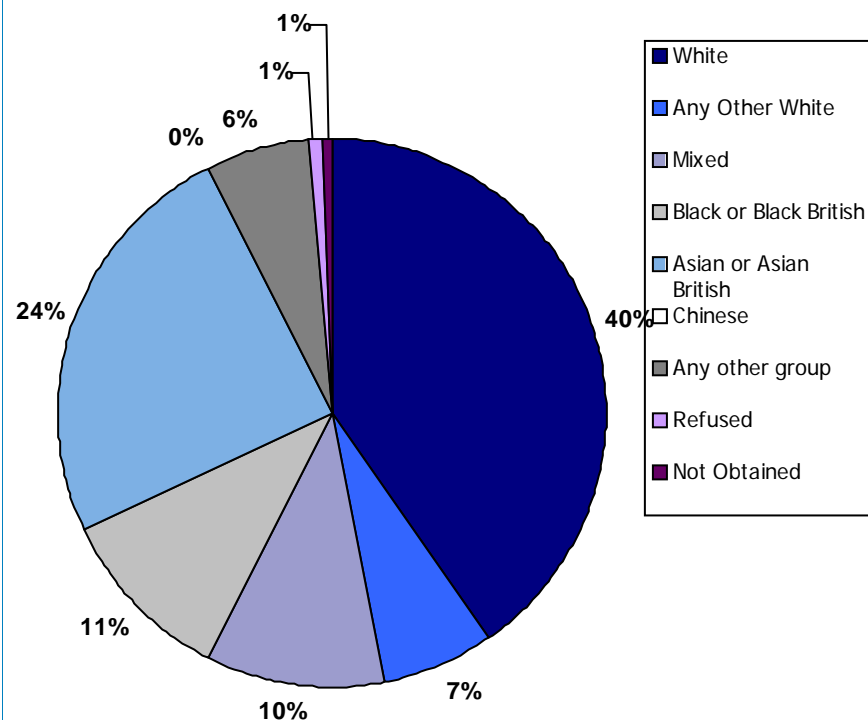

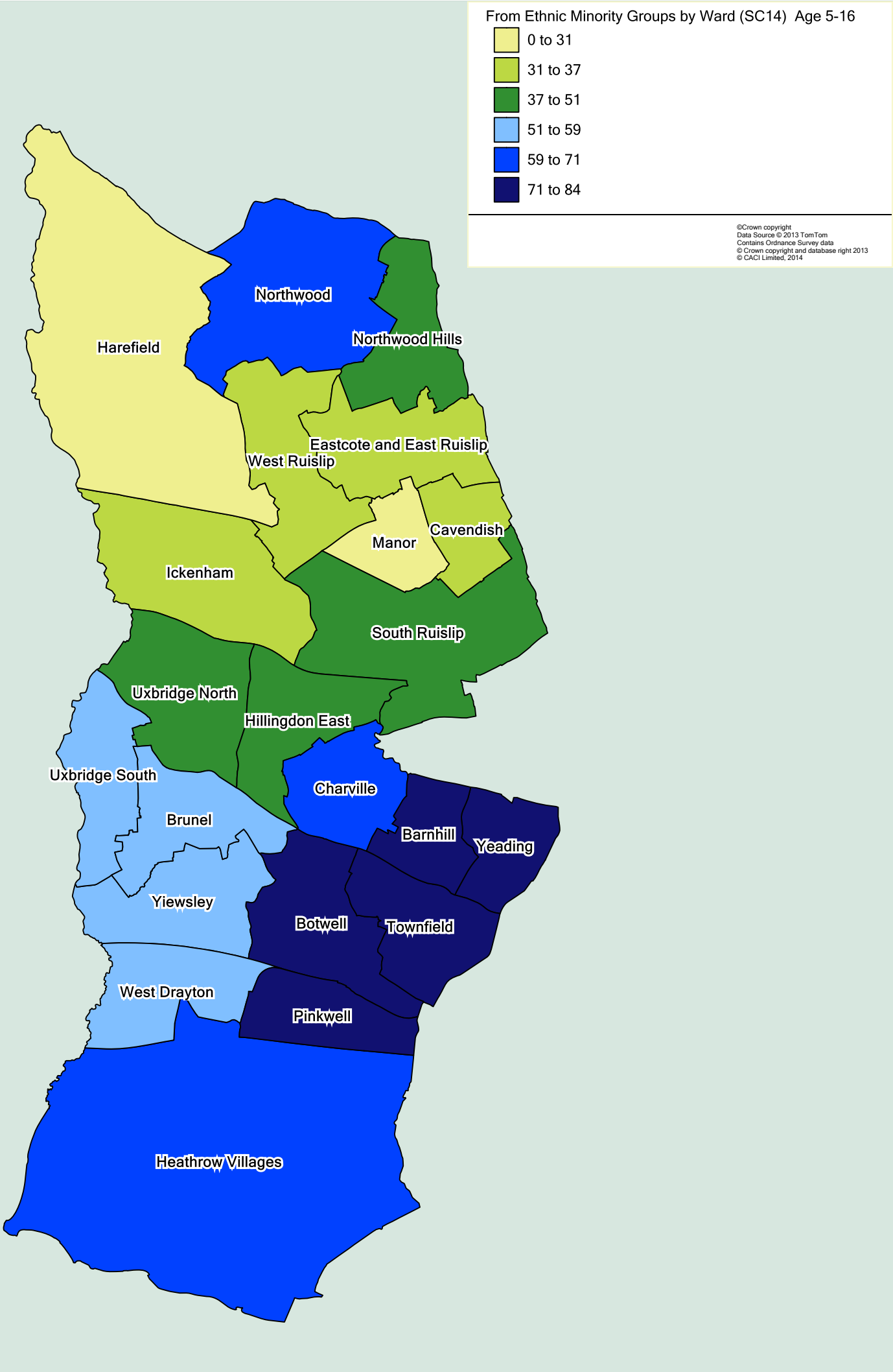

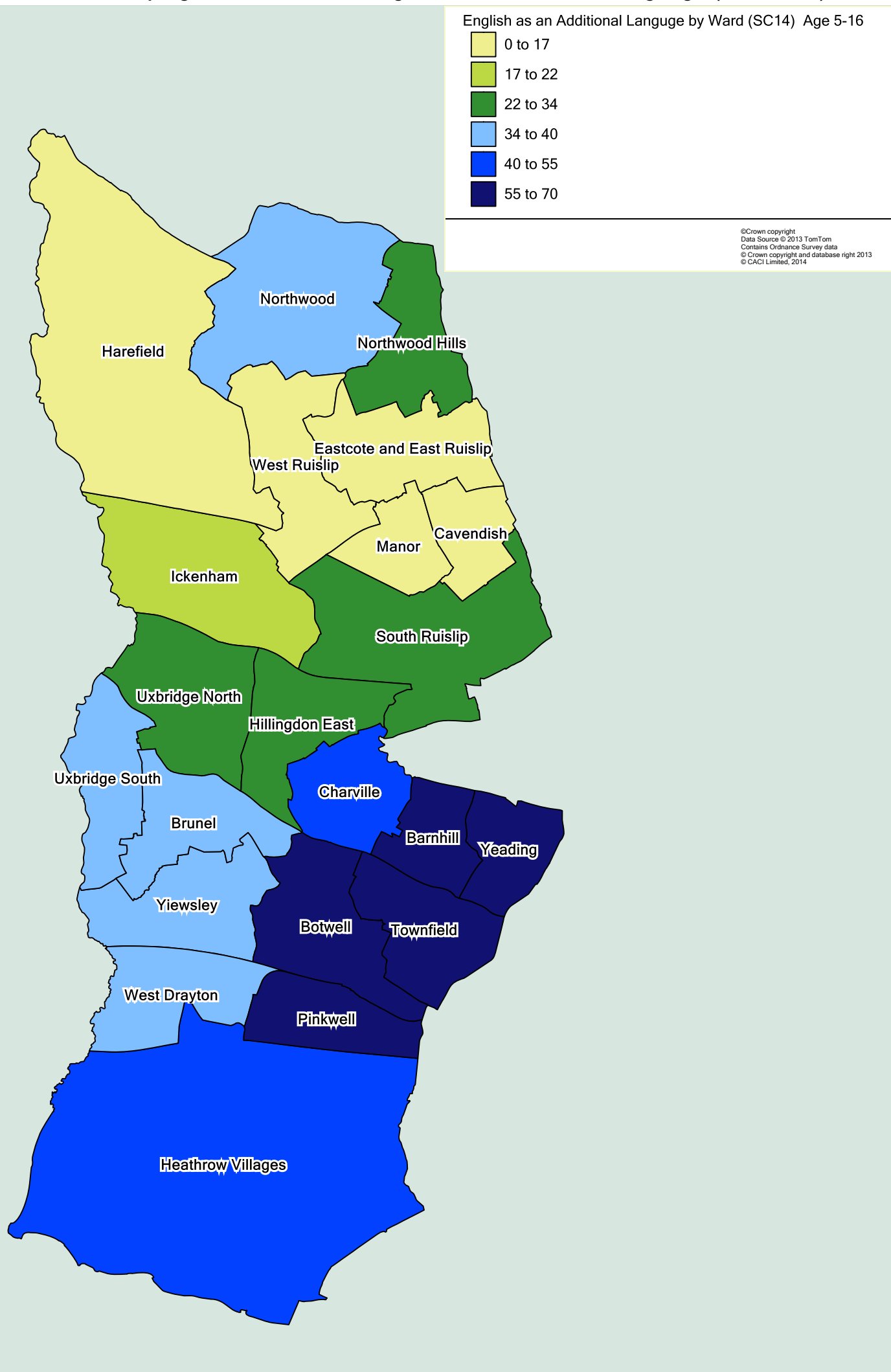

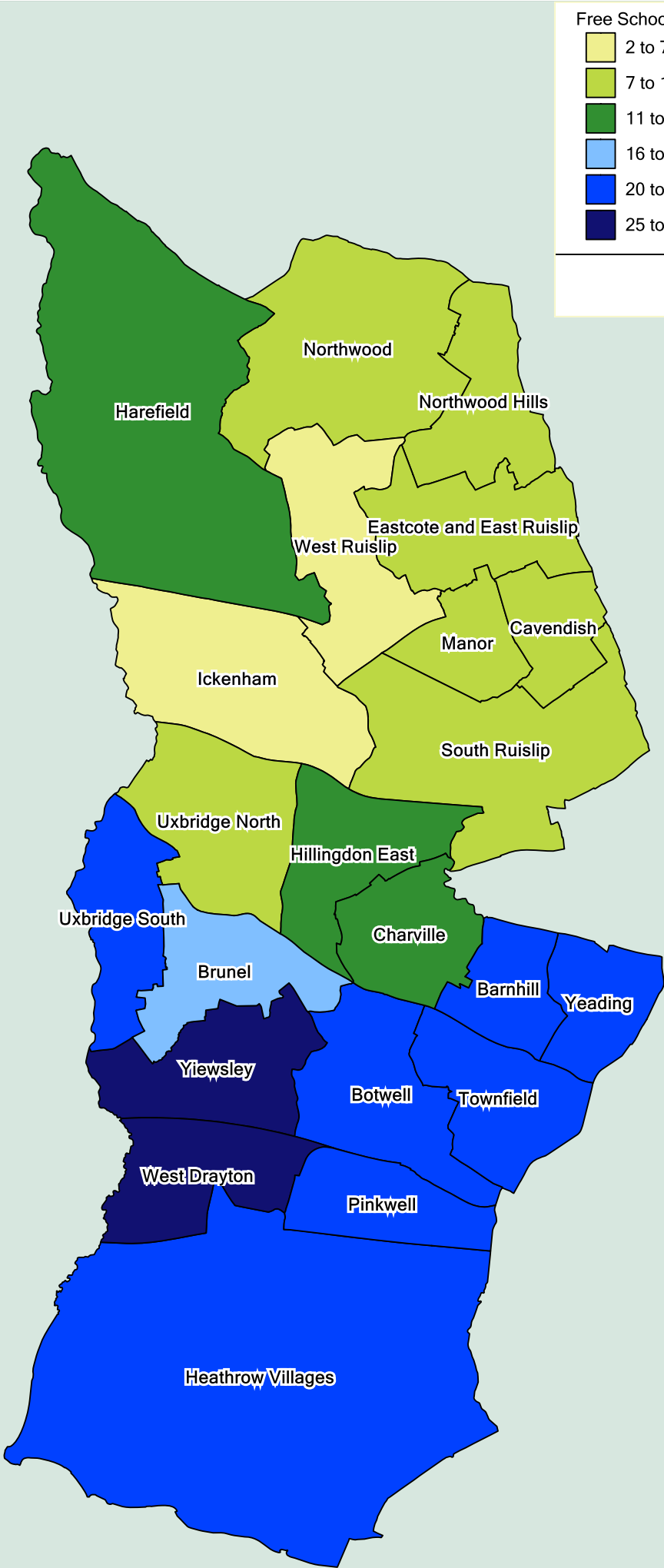

% School Population aged 5 to 16 known to be eligible for FSM (Jan SC14)



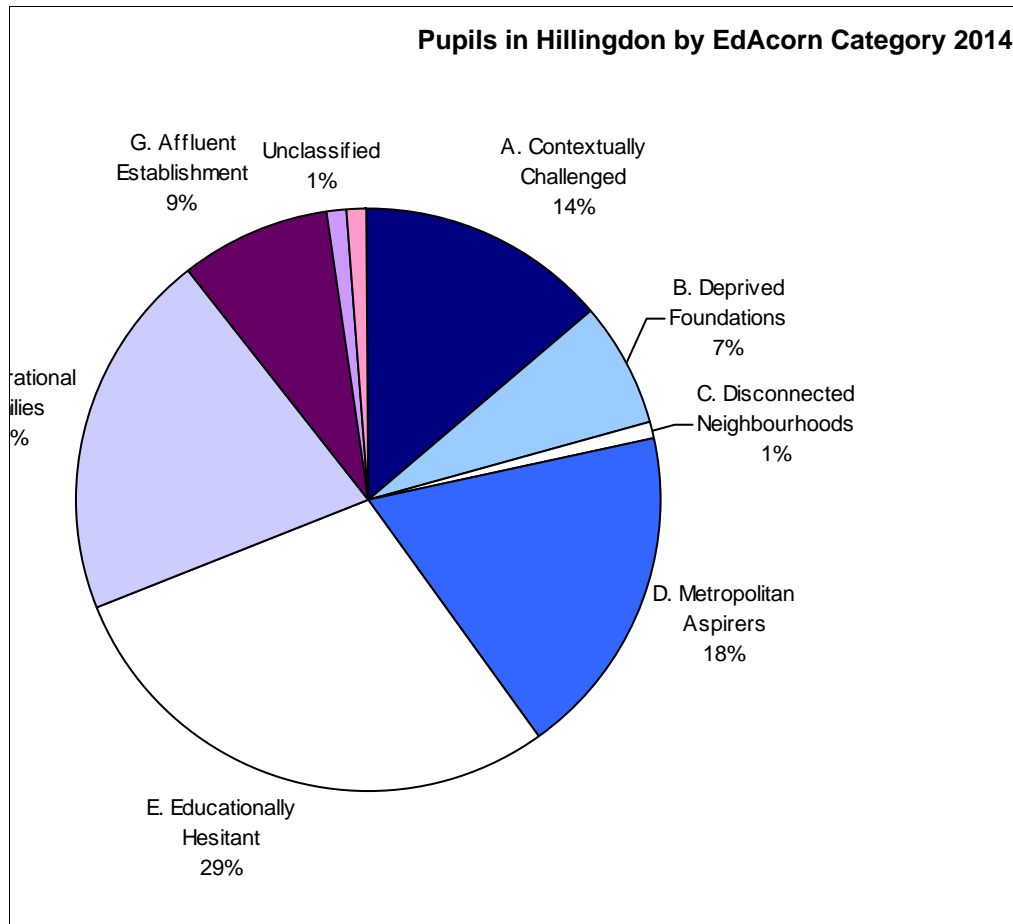
Free School Meals Eligibility by Ward (SC14) Age 5-16

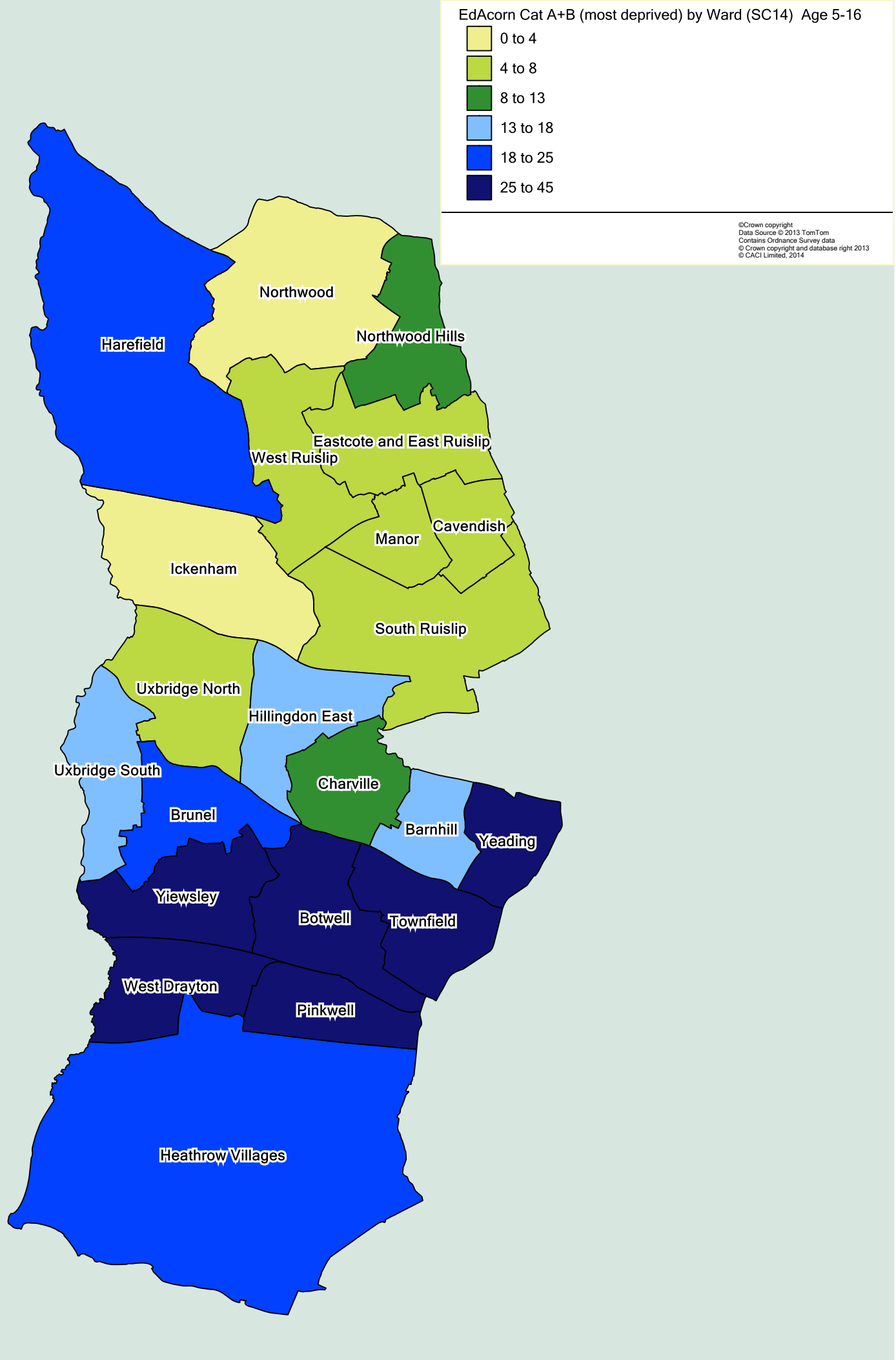

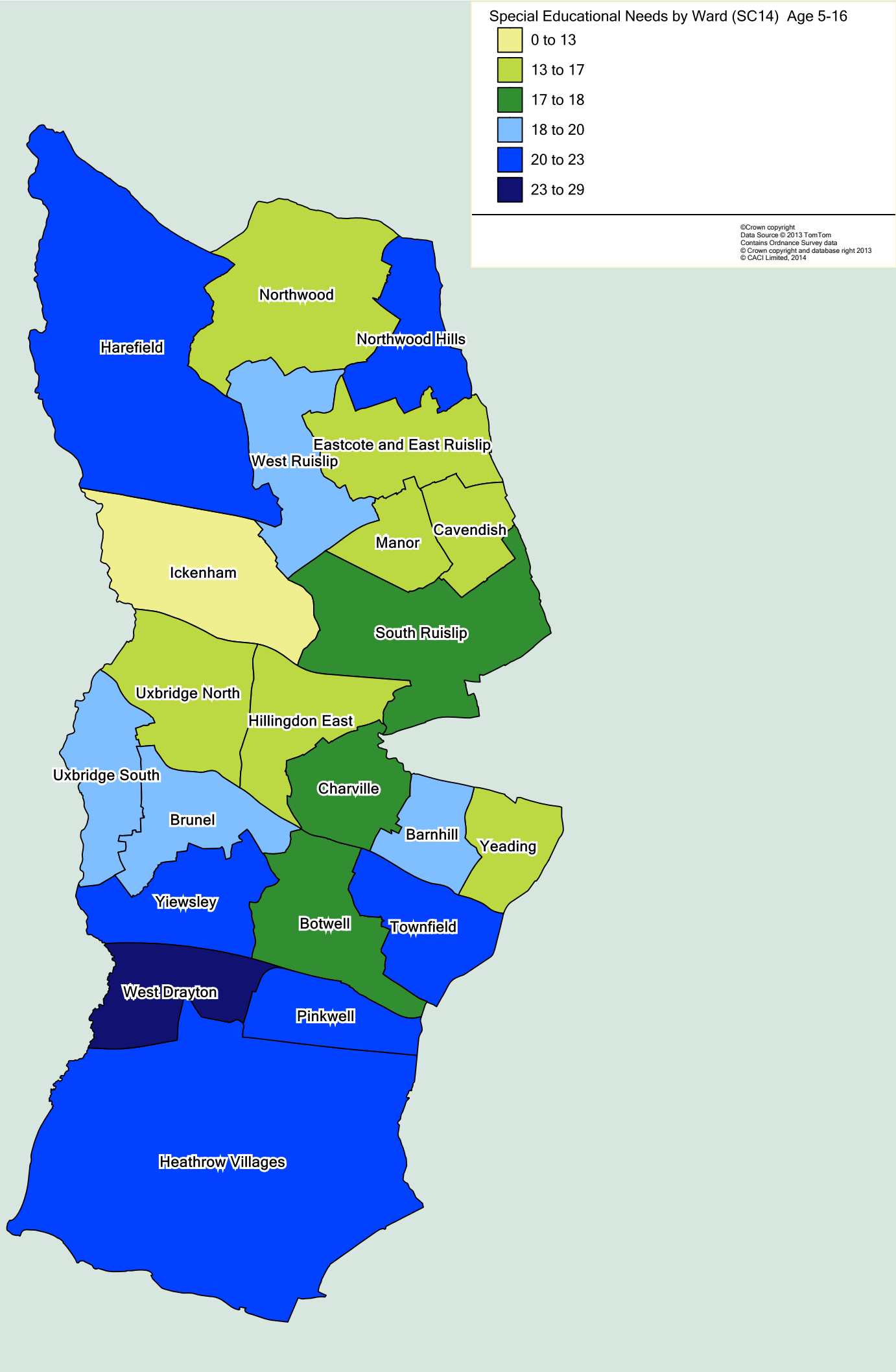

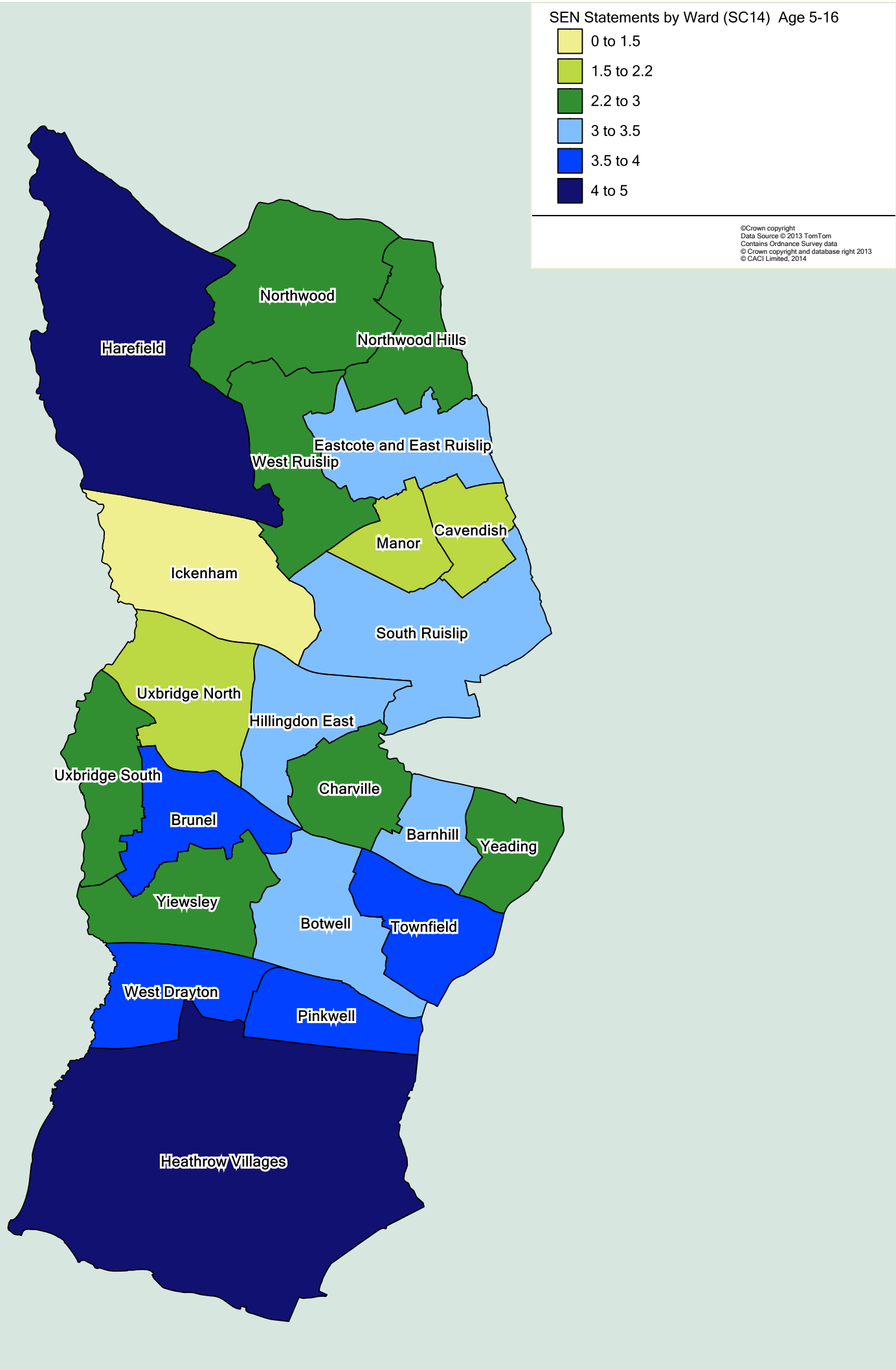

% School Pop aged 5 to 16 with a Statement of Special Educational Needs (Jan SC14)



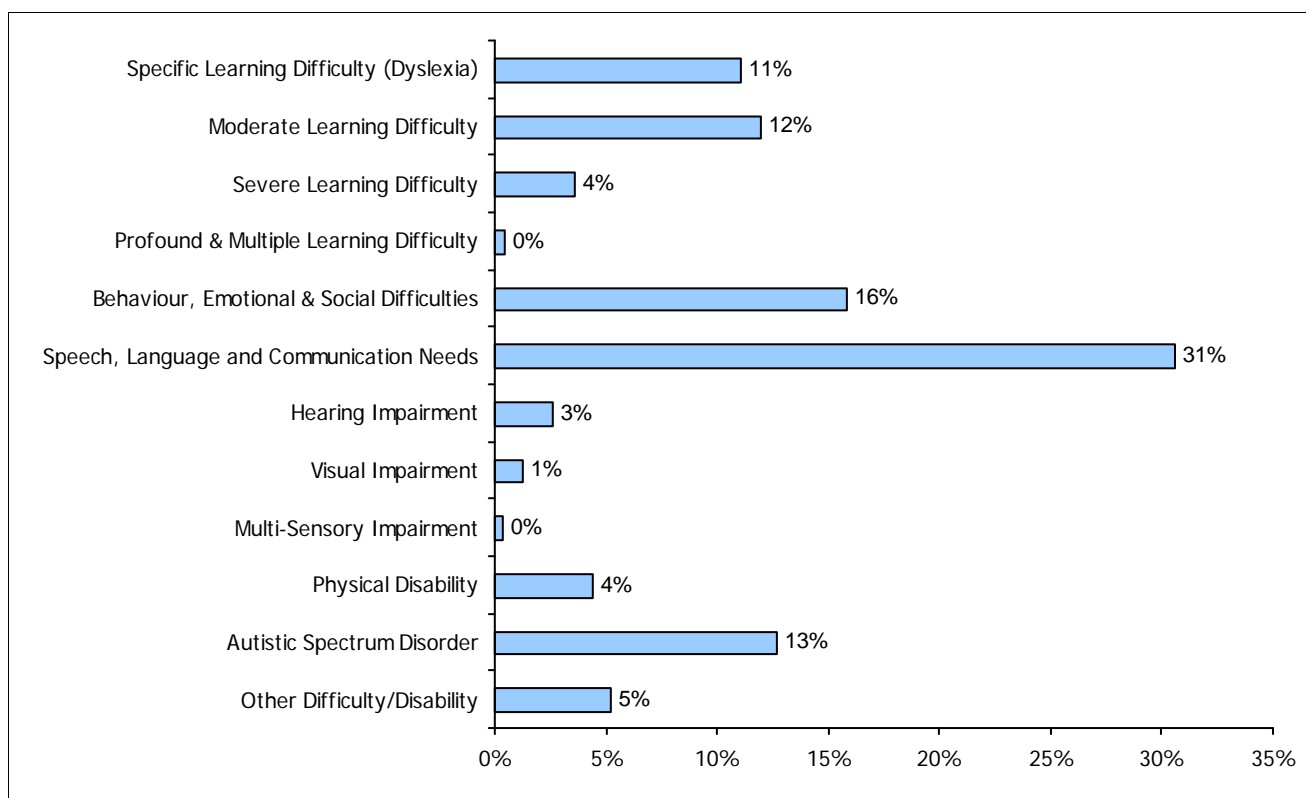
