

Welfare reform and tenancy support



The Welfare Reform and Tenancy Support Team provides timely and effective case work interventions which prevent high cost crisis intervention, homelessness and recurring homelessness by sustaining tenancies at risk due to underlying social and medical vulnerabilities.

These vulnerabilities could be mental ill health, a physical disability, being an ex offender, not being able to communicate effectively in English.

Interventions include helping people to open bank accounts, apply for benefits to which they are entitled and safeguarding measures to prevent exploitation.

These interventions have prevented people from being evicted from their property and supported their long term health and wellbeing.
