AXIS & Mobile detached team

The AXIS & Mobile Detached Team serves children and young people in the community delivering 1:1 intervention through youth work or targeted group sessions via a Youth Bus.

A Black British child had been identified as being significantly challenging in the family home and there were also issues in the community. The child's vulnerabilities around exploitation and serious youth violence were increasing, and there seemed to be a lack of relationship and understanding of their behaviour in the community.

The Mobile Detached Team identified the child in the community and formed a positive relationship with them, maintain ongoing engagement.

Due to this, the vulnerabilities around their additional needs, anxieties and desires to be accepted by their peers was more easily captured and prevention/disruption could be further implemented.

The child was able to share their anxieties of living in their community, and how they felt they were perceived by others. This was regularly shared with the professional network for more insight.

The child contacted Mobile Detached Team when they committed a serious crime and allowed support from the team to co-operate with the Police.

Network Crime Practitioners attended all strategy/high risk panel meetings to offer clarity on the child's activity, offer solutions and further understanding of the vulnerability of their needs in the community from a contextual safeguarding lense.

The child continues to have a positive relationship with the Mobile Detached Team and more trusting relationships with their peers.
